<p>Write 5 subtraction sentences in chalk. Draw a picture to go with them!</p>	<p>Play the card game "war" with a grown-up. Bonus if you email a picture to the teacher!</p>	<p>Count how many stuffed animals you have.</p>	<p>Write numbers 50-100 in pencil, chalk, or paint</p> <p>50-100</p>
<p>Count to 100 out loud to your favorite stuffy. Then count to a grown-up.</p>	<p>Play a number memory game with a deck of cards</p>	<p>Do a nature scavenger hunt (5 leaves, 4 rocks, etc.) Add up what you found!</p>	<p>Play a board game that uses dice or counting to move spots</p>
