Holy Trinity School, established in 1833, holds the distinction of being the oldest school in Lorain County and one of the ten largest in the Diocese of Cleveland. Our rich history began when three families from Bavaria settled in Avon, Ohio. The parish school commenced in 1845, originally housed in a log cabin near the intersection of Schwartz and Nagel Roads.


Today, the community continues to flourish. Holy Trinity School has more than 550 students from Preschool through 8th grade, with two classes per grade. Our preschool typically accommodates around 90 students. Our enrollment has grown and remained steady over the last ten years, reflecting our commitment to providing a stable and nurturing educational environment.

At Holy Trinity School, our mission calls us to prepare students to know, love, and serve God. Rooted in Gospel teachings, we are stewards of our Catholic faith and strive to do our best through creativity and innovation. 

# Capital Improvements & Campus Safety

With the continued support of our families and parish community, and grant writing we've been able to invest in both our facilities and our approach to campus safety over the last three years. These updates help us care for our buildings, enrich daily school life, and reinforce a secure environment. Below is a three year snapshot of our capital improvements and safety initiatives that we have completed to maintain our historic building.

In Fall 2025, we invited the state of Ohio to conduct a Security Vulnerability Assessment of our campus. After a successful walkthrough we were able to improve on certain measures such as adding proper window coverage to our doors with windows as well as installing Nightlock barriers on all our classroom doors in the event of an emergency.

In Spring 2026, we will have the Centegix Safety Platform installed, a school safety alert and communication system designed to help staff quickly request assistance during an emergency. Centegix will provide fast, campus wide notification to key responders and administrators, supporting clearer communication and quicker coordination when seconds matter. This addition strengthens our overall safety plan and our commitment to a secure, well-prepared school environment. It will also enable any staff member to have a direct line to the Avon Police Department through this device.

## Faith in Action/Service Highlights

- Our junior high students completed over 3,000 service hours in 2025
- \$31,000 dollars raised for St. Baldrick's
- Students completed service projects for homebound parishioners, Arrupe & Footpath Foundation, Shanerock, and Cornerstone Pregnancy.
- Students collected 2,250 items for Fostering Hope.



## Intro to Preschool

- Students turning 3 by August 1
- Meets Mondays–Wednesdays (3 days/week)

- Class size: 14 students with a teacher and aide
