



PROXY VOTING (YEAR)

A voting member of the NZIMLS is defined under Rule 12(b) as a Life Member, Fellow, Member or an Associate. Under Rule 6(d) an Associate is defined as any person engaged in Medical Laboratory Science who is not eligible for any other class of membership.

A voting member may appoint another voting member as his/her proxy to vote on their behalf at any meeting of the NZIMLS which he/she is unable to attend. In accordance with Rule 12(f)(i) a member wishing to appoint a proxy must lodge a statement of appointment with the Executive Officer, seven days prior to the commencement of the meeting.

The Proxy Form below may be used by members who will be unable to attend the Annual General Meeting to be held in September. A copy should be completed and lodged with the Executive Officer and entitles the proxy named therein to vote on behalf of the absent member.

It is customary for a proxy to vote on behalf of the absent member at his/her own discretion after hearing the discussion at the meeting. If the member wishes his/her proxy to vote in a predetermined way on a particular proposal regardless of any discussion which may occur, he/she may instruct his/her proxy accordingly. Any such direction is a personal arrangement between the member and his/her proxy and should not be declared on the proxy form.
