Entry Form & Payment: District Commissioners will enter all competitors from their respective clubs.

Entry fees and stabling fees must be paid via the online form using a credit card (a processing fee of

3% will be added to the total amount due.)

All Coggins AND PROOF OF VACCINATION must be uploaded with entry.

**Veterinary Requirements:** 

#### **NEW: BOTH COGGINS & PROOF OF VACCINATION DUE WITH ENTRIES**

- Coggins Tests: The Region will collect Coggins tests with club team entries & verify validity
- Vaccinations: Influenza and Rhinopneumonitis (EHV-1/4) no less than 7 days and no more than 6 months before visiting.
- Certificates of Veterinary Inspection/Health Certificates are required by State Law for Horses attending from out-of-state and are location specific.

Visit our website for more details and to download the required forms. Paperwork will be verified before unloading your horse: <u>Tri-State Region Biosecurity</u>

Mounts may be shared by up to three competitors; this must be indicated on entry form.

**Stabling:** Stalls with doors on grounds.

Stalls are required for the day of the competition.

\$30 for overnight (Sat-Sun) **Bedding not provided.** 

We will not be collecting Stall Deposit Checks. Clubs will be billed \$25 per competitor for any stalls left uncleaned. Stalls must be checked by Horse Management Staff or a Rally Organizer before leaving the show grounds.

STALL CARDS and FEED CHARTS—both are required.

Tack Stalls: Tack trailers will be utilized for this rally due to limited number of stalls available. When forming teams,

please consider trailer availability!

**Coaching:** Riding Coaches are required. Coaches are optional for the Running, Shooting &

Swimming phases. Riding coach must be designated on Entry Forms. All coaches

must sign a Tetrathlon Coaching Guidelines Form.

Written Test: Completion of an open-book written test will be required (one test per team.)

Attire: Dress in all Phases should be appropriate for the sport & weather conditions. One-piece

swimsuits required. Supplied pinnie/nametag & USPC pin should be worn at all times. Dress for the Riding Phase consists of an approved helmet, a collared shirt with sleeves, jodhpurs or breeches, and tall boots or paddock boots with or without a matching smooth leather half-chap. No jackets required, vests are optional. Blunt spurs are permitted. Refer to USPC Horse Management Handbook Rules for Rallies 2025 and USPC Tetrathlon Rulebook 2025

pgs. 11-12 for specifics.

A Medical Armband/Medical Bracelet must be worn at all times while on the competition grounds. The Medical Armband MUST have a completed Medical Card MUST be worn on either the right or left upper arm. Competitors are not required to wear them while actually shooting or swimming but must have them visible and next to them for these activities and must wear them

at all other times.

<u>Tack:</u> Crops are permitted (max. 30".) Running martingales with rein stops are permitted.

Acceptable bits are defined in the latest version of the USPC Handbook and Rules for Show Jumping

Competition.

<u>Volunteers:</u> Each team must provide 2 volunteers. *DO NOT enter the same name multiple times unless* 

submitting a short team (one or two riders.) A third volunteer would be greatly appreciated!

Volunteers will be contacted via email to indicate their position preferences.

Levels & Divisions: (Separate divisions for Boys & Girls) See Articles 29 & 30 on page 9 of the Rulebook for details

(see also Appendix VI and refer to individual phase rules for competition specifications.)

Note for Jump Phase: the minimum number of spreads for every level is 3 out of first 8 jumping efforts plus 1 for each 4 more efforts.

Please note: Individuals entered to scramble will be placed on a scramble team with members from other clubs. If there is a request to scramble with a particular club please make note of this on the entry form, but be advised that this cannot be guaranteed.

### **Championships:**

This rally will qualify members for 2026 Championships.

### **Riding at a Lower Competition Level**

Qualifying competitors may ride down one level. Non-qualifying competitors may ride down more than one level. A 300 point penalty will apply for the first drop in distance and an additional 100 points for each additional distance dropped.

### **Run & Swim at Lower Competition Levels**

Competitors may choose to run or swim at a shorter distance than what is specified for their competition level. A 400 point penalty will apply for the first drop in distance and an additional 200 points for each additional distance dropped. The intention of swimming or running a shorter distance must be declared on the entry form.

**Food:** No concessions available on-site.
