The 2023 Richland County Ag + Art Tour featured stops at 15 farms and farm-related businesses in Blythewood, Eastover, Hopkins, and Columbia. These sites showcased the diversity of local agriculture, including the production of fruits, vegetables, livestock, cut flowers, nursery and greenhouse stock, and forest products.



100+ artisans

Each tour site featured local artisans, including painters, potters, authors, photographers, bakers, and musicians. More than 100 artisans were stationed at Richland County's 15 tour sites during the 2023 tour!



3.000+ Tourists
