PLEASE FOLLOW THESE SIMPLE CART PLACEMENT GUIDELINES:

- Place cart at the curb by 6:30 AM
- Place carts 3 feet apart with the handle toward the house
- Place carts at least 3 feet from cars, trees and mailboxes
- Ensure carts' wheels are as close to the curb as possible

NO PLASTIC BAGS IN
YOUR RECYCLING CART

Item	Rule	Expert Tip
NO Bagged Recyclables or Loose Plastic Bags	Place clean, dry items directly into your recycling cart. Loose plastic bags can get tangled in recycling equipment and threaten worker safety.	Learn how to recycle plastic bags safely at plasticfilmrecycling.org .
NO Plastic Wraps & Film	Plastic wrap, bubble wrap, or plastic sandwich and freezer bags are not allowed.	Reuse whenever possible for packing, moving, or storing other household items.
NO Flexible Packaging	Flexible packaging, like chip bags, juice and soup pouches should not be placed in your curbside recycling cart. Place it in the trash.	Because it is made from multiple materials, this type of packaging cannot be recycled.
