Latin America and the Caribbean trade with PortMiami was strong in Q3 FY2026, reaching 113,671 TEUs, up roughly 21% from 93,949 TEUs in Q3 FY2025. Trade value remained essentially stable at \$11.2 million, compared with \$11.3 million the prior year. Trade was balanced at 51% exports and 49% imports—highlighting PortMiami's continued role as a key gateway in the region.

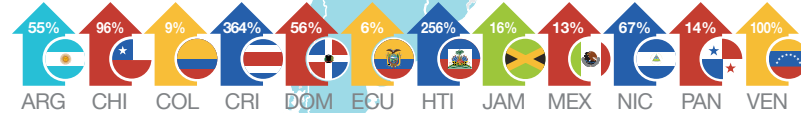
