

Paint the Pig Guidelines & FAQs

Q. Where does the money go from this contest?

A. 100% of the fees collected will be used for production of the 2026 Preble County Pork Festival. This is a fundraiser event.

Q. My business already has a pig from a previous festival - may I still participate?

A. Absolutely! We want to see pigs everywhere in the County to spread our excitement about the festival!

Q. We are a large business and would like multiple pigs; may we enter both for the voting contest?

A. Yes! We love to see some friendly competition amongst the teams! When submitting, please identify as "Company Name -Team (Number or Name)" for each.

Q. Do we get to keep our pig once the contest has ended?

A. YES! We love to see the support in the county all year round about the festival! Not to mention, the pigs are always an amazing conversation piece for new visitors to your business - what a way to showcase Preble County!

Q. What paint should we use?

A. Outdoor Latex Paint (such as Porter Paint Acry-Shield}. The first coat should be a thinned paint of 50/50 mix of paint/water. Next, detail or dry brush with full strength paint. Remember to remove about 90% of the paint from the paint brush as you remove from can/tray. Lightly paint until you achieve the look you are wanting to accomplish. **You can always add more paint, but you can't remove it.**

Q. What if we accidentally chip, crack, or break part of the pig?

A. To make any repairs, use a Bonda (2-part mix} to fill in cracks or breaks.

Q. If we win the contest, do we win a prize?

A. We will make a PIG deal out of your brand in all marketing & festival festivities! You will gain additional brand exposure to tens of thousands!
