Entry Details & Directions

Entry Fee:

- \$20 per child
- Non-refundable
- Payment will be taken at the event beginning at Noon or parents can mail in their registration paper with a check. For those entering beforehand, their pageant numbers will be assigned prior to the event and parents will check in separately just for their number.

Contest Format

1. Festival Wear (75%)

- Sunday best, farm-themed, or Pork Festival attire
- No heavy makeup
- No flippers, fake hair, or excessive pageant styling
- Natural hair encouraged
- Boys and girls welcome

Judging criteria:

 - Smile & personality
 - Posture & stage presence
 - Overall neatness

2. On-Stage Introduction (25%)

Each child:

- Walks on stage
- Says name and favorite thing about the Pork Festival. This may be asked by the emcee.
- For younger division, parent or emcee will assist.

Judging criteria:

- Ability to speak clearly (age appropriate)

 - Personality

1st place Miss and Mister:

- Crown
- Sash
- \$50 in Piggy Bucks (Must be used during 2026 festival weekend)

1st Runner-Up each division Miss and Mister sash and \$10 Piggy Bucks.
