



Membership Code of Conduct

Southern Queensland Landscapes is a community organisation based on inclusion, respect, and support between its staff and members. It is a welcoming and supportive environment for all people and organisations in our region with an interest in natural resource management. In order to maintain respectful behavior and a supportive environment, SQ Landscapes requires members, both individuals and organisations, to accept and abide by a code of conduct. This code outlines standards of behavior and ethical conduct that ensure an effective, diverse and respectful environment.

Membership Code of Conduct

All members of SQ Landscapes undertake to:

- Abide by the rules of SQ Landscapes as set out in its Constitution;
- Uphold the reputation and good standing of Southern Queensland Landscapes Management;
- Treat others with respect.
- Behave and communicate in ways that are respectful, inclusive and supportive of others;
- Abide by the appropriate laws that apply to personal conduct;
- Act at all times in the interest of the organisation and not act to derive personal benefit from participation in the organisation;
- Not make any statement on behalf of SQ Landscapes or purport to represent SQ Landscapes through any public medium, including digital social media, unless authorised to do so by SQ Landscapes; and
- Conduct all business with SQ Landscapes and its partners with professionalism and respect.

An application for membership of SQ Landscapes indicates a willingness to accept and abide by the Membership Code of Conduct.

Breaching this Code of Conduct, may result in SQ Landscapes terminating membership.

SQ Landscapes may update this Membership Code of Conduct from time to time.
