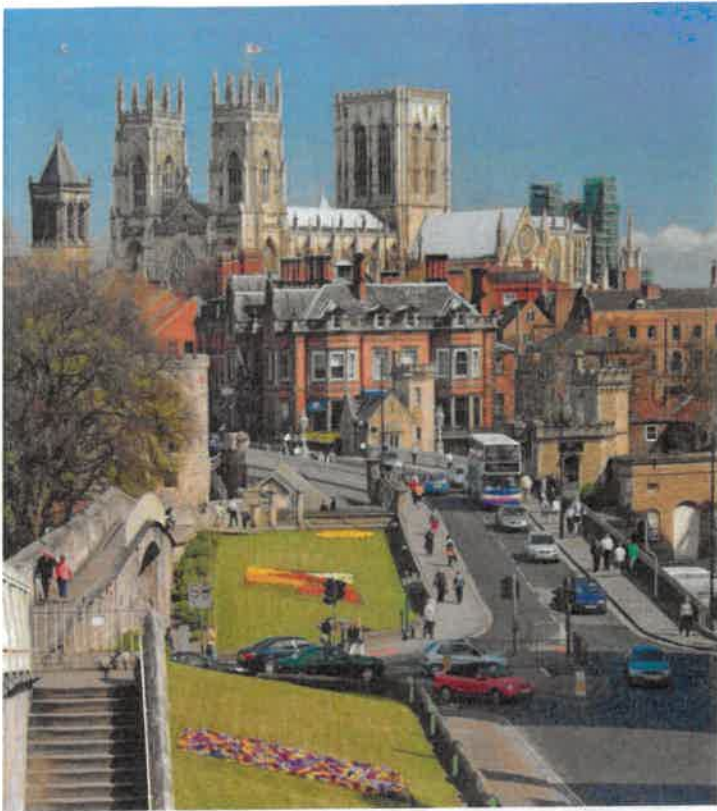

Day 1: Saturday, April 3, 2027 Overnight Flight

Feel the vibrant energy of England, hear the unique sounds of Scotland, and see the rolling countryside of Wales on a trip that combines dramatic history and an array of fascinating landscapes.

Day 2: Sunday, April 4, 2027 Arrive Edinburgh, Scotland

Your tour begins in Edinburgh, the historic capital of Scotland, where rocky hills, towers in the distance, and the shadows of history can be seen around every corner. With no scheduled sightseeing today take some time to discover Scotland's capital for yourself and see how medieval crossroads blend seamlessly with a vibrant modern energy.

Day 3: Monday, April 5, 2027 Edinburgh

Enjoy time to get to know the place where your journey begins. This evening, join your fellow travellers for a welcome dinner. (B, D)

Day 4: Tuesday, April 6, 2027 Edinburgh

Start the day with a panoramic and walking tour of old and new Edinburgh, exploring Georgian architecture, writers and monuments, alleyways and hidden passages, and the dark and mysterious side of the city. Then, walk up the Royal Mile to enter Edinburgh Castle, home to the Scottish Crown Jewels. After a guided tour of the castle grounds, enjoy time to explore the city as you wish this afternoon and evening. Perhaps you will choose to join an optional night of Scottish food, song, and dance. (B)

Day 5: Wednesday, April 7, 2027 Edinburgh - York, England

Say goodbye to the rolling hills of Scotland while travelling south on a local passenger train to York. After you arrive, join a walk to get familiar with York's streets before taking some free time to enjoy lunch on your own. After an afternoon visit to the magnificent York Minster, the rest of the day is yours to explore independently. This evening, you may wish to join an optional tour to a family-run Yorkshire vineyard and sample a selection of English wines over a traditional home-cooked dinner. (B)

Day 6: Thursday, April 8, 2027 York - Chester

This morning, travel to Chester, your home for the next two nights, where ancient walls enclose charming Tudor and Victorian houses. Discover the charms of the city with your local guide before taking some time for lunch. This afternoon, **it's your choice!** Enjoy a guided tour of the magnificent Chester Cathedral **-OR-** take a leisurely boat ride along the tranquil River Dee. (B, D)

Day 7: Friday, April 9, 2027 Chester - Conwy, Wales - Llangollen - Chester, England

Today, venture to the inviting town of Conwy in Wales. Visit Conwy Castle to discover the history behind one of Edward I's most imposing castles and take a leisurely stroll around town, seeking out local shops, cafés, and markets. Then take a scenic drive to the picturesque town of Llangollen. Stand on the bridge to watch the fast-flowing waters beneath and take in the hustle and bustle of this charming, popular town. (B)

Day 8: Saturday, April 10, 2027 Chester - Stratford-upon-Avon

Step back in time on a journey through the English countryside to Stratford-upon-Avon — the Bard's birthplace. Join for a walk through the town's busy streets and then sit down to a traditional English afternoon tea. Tour the childhood home of William Shakespeare, and take time to explore this historic market town on your own. (B, L)

Day 9: Sunday, April 11, 2027 Stratford-upon-Avon - London

Bid farewell to Stratford and travel to the esteemed capital - London. Upon arriving in the bustling Covent Garden area, take some time and have lunch on your own. Then, join a local guide for a three-hour walking tour, taking in the iconic landmarks of Westminster from the outside, including Big Ben, the Houses of Parliament, Westminster Abbey, and Buckingham Palace. Later, settle in at your hotel and spend the evening in the city as you wish. (B)

Day 10: Monday, April 12, 2027 London

Take in London your way today with a full day at leisure. Or, you may wish to join an optional tour to Windsor Castle, the majestic residence that has been the home of British royalty for centuries, offering a glimpse into the lives of monarchs past and present. (B, D)

Day 11: Tuesday, April 13, 2027 London

Enjoy a day of leisure. (B)

Experience It! Conwy, Wales

One of the loveliest towns to explore on the northern coast of Wales is Conwy (from Old Welsh cyn "chief" and gwy "water"). Originally an English military outpost built in the 13th century, it retains beautifully preserved medieval walls as well as the towering fortress known as Conwy Castle, with eight lofty towers complete with spiral staircases. This mighty monument, standing high above the small town and the riverbank, was built, amazingly, in just four years by the English King Edward I and his architect. UNESCO has designated the castle a World Heritage Site, noted as one of the finest examples of late 13th- and early 14th-century military architecture in Europe. Stretching across from the castle lie the town, the river, and the craggy mountains of Snowdonia. The town itself, notable for its scenic harbour front, is dotted with quaint cafés, tearooms, and markets that beckon travellers.

Windsor Castle

Step into the formal world of the British Monarchy when you visit the stately and expansive Windsor Castle. His Majesty King Charles III uses Windsor as both a private home and as a Royal residence where formal duties of province are performed. Windsor's 1,000 rooms comprise the largest inhabited castle in the world. It dates back to the 1070's, when William the Conqueror built the original wooden structure, now replaced by the grand stone edifices. Explore one of Britain's most visited historic buildings, its precincts, and the Province Apartments, which house a delightful collection of Royal art treasures. Enjoy time for lunch in the quaint town of Windsor before heading back to London. This once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to visit the castle that houses so much British history and lore is not to be missed! *Duration: Approximately 6 hours.* Please note a minimum of 8 passengers is required. Transportation is included.
