

Sacrament of Matrimony: In order to properly prepare for marriage, it is expected that the couple contact the pastor before making other arrangements for the wedding. This initial contact should be at least one year prior to the desired date of marriage.

Sacrament of Baptism: Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays at Our Lady of Grace at 1:00 p.m., and at Most Precious Blood immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass, which parents and Godparents are expected to attend. You must be a registered member of Our Lady of Peace Parish. Godparents must be baptized Catholics who are practicing their faith. Expectant parents are required to receive instruction before the baptism of their child. If you are expecting a child in the next six months, please contact the parish office to register for this instruction.

Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor: It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis.

To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.

Council Announcement October 2025

As the pastor of our newly formed parish, one of my first tasks has been to seat new councils, which serve in an advisory capacity as we navigate the future of Our Lady of Peace Parish. A Finance Council is required in every parish by both the Code of Canon Law and diocesan regulation. To be effective, the Finance Council should meet regularly with specific agendas and should have access to all the relevant financial information and policies of the parish. While the Finance Council does not have decision making authority, consultation is at the heart of the decision-making process – sharing information, listening, contributing to the discussion, and promoting consensus. A Pastoral Council is also recommended by Canon Law. The Pastoral Council examines and considers all that relates to pastoral work and proposes practical ideas to the pastor concerning the on-going life and mission of the parish. Developing a shared vision for growing in faith together, reaching out beyond the walls of the church, and providing meaningful spiritual experiences is the work of the Pastoral Council.

The parishioners who have agreed to serve on these councils represent both faith communities that have come together to form our combined parish. I am grateful for the willingness of each of individual to serve our parish community.

The councils will meet jointly on November 19,

2025 to get a better understanding of the current state of the parish, particularly as they relate to our facilities. Please join me in welcoming our new council members.

En el día de los difuntos

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo: En este día en que recordamos con respeto y amor a nuestros difuntos, la Palabra

nos abre un horizonte de esperanza. En la lectura del Libro de la Sabiduría escuchamos: Las almas de los justos están en las manos de Dios y ningún tormento las alcanzará. No es un simple consuelo superficial: es el anuncio de que la fidelidad de Dios trasciende incluso la muerte. La vida de los que en Él creemos no termina, se transforma. Esa transformación es el centro de nuestra fe: nuestros seres queridos, aunque ya no los veamos, están acogidos por el Amor que no falla.

San Pablo, en su carta a los Romanos, nos explica cómo esta vida transformada viene a partir de la unión con Cristo: Si hemos muerto con Cristo, creemos que también viviremos con Él; sabiendo que Cristo, habiendo resucitado de entre los muertos, ya no muere. Él nos invita a considerarnos «muertos al pecado, pero vivos para Dios». Esa vida nueva, aunque aún no la veamos plenamente, ya nos pertenece, y se extiende más allá de los límites temporales de este mundo. La muerte no es un salto al vacío para perderse en la nada; la muerte es un salto a la vida.

Y en el Evangelio de San Juan, Jesús nos dice que Él ha venido para que tengamos vida y la tengamos en abundancia. Esa promesa ilumina también nuestra partida de este mundo. Porque no estamos llamados al olvido, sino al encuentro definitivo con Él. No es despedida sin sentido, sino tránsito hacia la plenitud.

Por tanto, al mirar a nuestros difuntos, no contemplemos sólo la pérdida, sino la esperanza. Ellos descansan en manos de Dios, según la Sabiduría; participan de la vida nueva que Pablo nos describe; están en el abrazo del Señor que promete vida abundante. Y nosotros, que permanecemos aquí, somos invitados a vivir con esta certeza. La vida de los que creemos se transforma, y no temer la muerte, sino a verla como paso hacia la luz. Que esta celebración nos fortalezca en la comunión de los santos: los que viven, los que han partido y los que vendrán. Aprovechemos para rezar por ellos, para pedir al Señor que les conceda la paz completa, y para renovar nuestro compromiso de vivir como hombres y mujeres de esperanza, testigos de la resurrección. Que nuestras obras de amor, de servicio, de fidelidad, sean el eco de la vida que ya han alcanzado.


