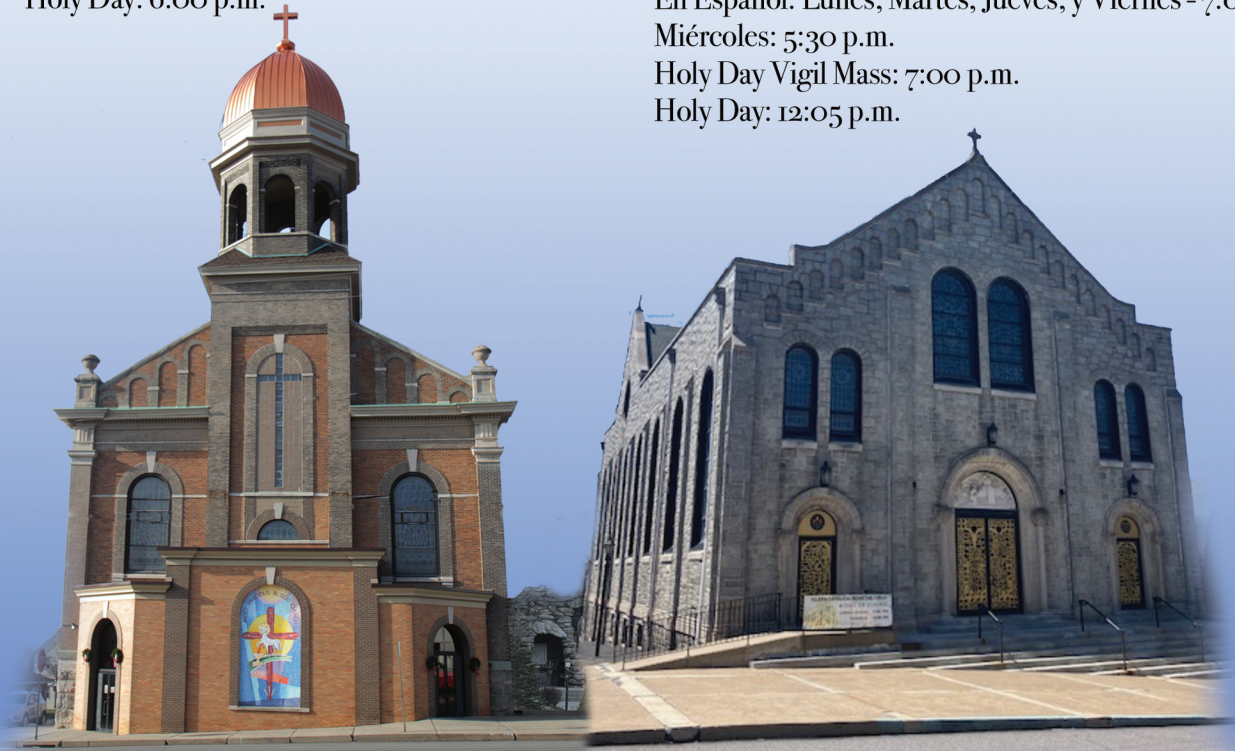

Sacrament of Matrimony: In order to properly prepare for marriage, it is expected that the couple contact the pastor before making other arrangements for the wedding. This initial contact should be at least one year prior to the desired date of marriage.

Sacrament of Baptism: Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays at Our Lady of Grace at 1:00 p.m., and at Most Precious Blood immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass, which parents and Godparents are expected to attend. You must be a registered member of Our Lady of Peace Parish. Godparents must be baptized Catholics who are practicing their faith. Expectant parents are required to receive instruction before the baptism of their child. If you are expecting a child in the next six months, please contact the parish office to register for this instruction.

Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor: It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis.

To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.

NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear family of Our Lady of Peace. Blessings to all. The word of the Lord reminds us that we have a treasure in Heaven. But to attain it, God Himself prepares us completely, making us stewards, not only of material things, but also of our reflections, judgments, and decisions, so that we may be responsible for the immediate present, knowing how to move forward toward a future illuminated by hope, as our father Abraham did. He was aware that he lived and dealt with a God who is life, resurrecting men. That is why Abraham did not fear to offer his son in sacrifice, because he had already understood that God is resurrection, is eternal life.

So why do men suffer from material goods? Do they become their condemnation?

Because they not only absolutize them, but they become intoxicated by them, distorting their judgment, conscience, will, and behavior.

That is why we find in the parable that the irresponsible servant ends up not feeding or giving drink to those entrusted to him and punishing them.

Because of this, I invite you not to become attached to anything that is not yours, but to become attached to the will of the one who has called you to be his and who has a treasure for us in heaven.

To attain this treasure, I must be conscious and alert, as he tells us: To whom much is given, much will be required, and to whom much is entrusted, much more will be required. I am truly happy to know that God has given me and entrusted me with so much, but it also makes me nervous because He has entrusted me with too much. His word, His sacraments, my brothers and sisters (the children of God). Sometimes we priests are afraid to proclaim the kingdom because of what our communities will say, and because of that, they do not advance in knowledge and conversion.

Have you ever wondered what God has entrusted to you? Have you administered it well? If today were the day we had to leave this world, would we truly be possessors of the heavenly treasure? Happy Sunday.
