

Sacrament of Matrimony: In order to properly prepare for marriage, it is expected that the couple contact the pastor before making other arrangements for the wedding. This initial contact should be at least one year prior to the desired date of marriage.

Sacrament of Baptism: Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays at Our Lady of Grace at 1:00 p.m., and at Most Precious Blood immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass, which parents and Godparents are expected to attend. You must be a registered member of Our Lady of Peace Parish. Godparents must be baptized Catholics who are practicing their faith. Expectant parents are required to receive instruction before the baptism of their child. If you are expecting a child in the next six months, please contact the parish office to register for this instruction.

Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor: It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis.

To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.

Parish Life is one of the aspects we consider when reviewing all the information that will help us to determine the future of Our Lady of Grace Church, along with finances, facilities, and priest availability. For this reason, I want to give you a little more detail about how the changing complexion of our city is reflected in our parish, using the statistics which were shared several weekends ago.

Over the last 5 years, the sacramental life at Queen of Heaven has been growing, with a total of 241 Baptisms, 93 First Communions, and 71 Confirmations. This has been a great blessing to our community! Upon closer examination, I discovered that 84% of these sacraments took place in our Hispanic community. In fact, last year only 8 sacraments were conferred in the English-speaking community: 1 Baptism, 4 First Communions, and 3 Confirmations. Sadly, the same is not true for funerals. Of the 37 funerals last year, only one was for a member of the Hispanic community. You can see how this reality mirrors the demographic changes in Hazleton.

The Hispanic community continues to grow in both size and vibrancy - so much so that they have outgrown the space at Our Lady of Grace and are seeking a new parish home that will better accommodate their needs. The linkage with Saints Cyril & Methodius may provide new opportunities for all of us, sharing not only a pastor but also welcoming one another into our churches and our homes.

As disciples of Christ, we are called to be good stewards of the many blessings God has provided, and to use all God bestows upon us to build up his Kingdom in our little section of the world. The future of Our Lady of Peace Parish is still unfolding. What do we need to accomplish the mission? How can we best use the resources at our disposal?

Over the next several weeks, I will continue to share information that will help us determine the future of Our Lady of Grace Church. I ask for your continued prayers as we discern the best way forward, together. May this Lenten season increase our attentiveness to the Holy Spirit's voice and may we be docile to God's direction.

QUERIDA FAMILIA DE NUESTRA SEÑORA DE LA PAZ:



El pasado 18 de febrero, con la imposición de la ceniza, iniciamos este tiempo fuerte de revisión interior y de cambios reales en nuestra vida, incluso cambios de conducta. No es un tiempo decorativo ni simbólico. Es un tiempo decisivo. Hoy, ya en este Primer Domingo de Cuaresma, la Palabra de Dios nos revela con claridad lo que está en juego: nuestra identidad, nuestra libertad y nuestro destino. El libro del Génesis nos presenta el origen de todo: Dios forma al hombre con ternura, sopla en él su propio aliento y lo coloca en un jardín, es decir, en un espacio de comunión, dignidad y vida. Pero también aparece la serpiente, que no representa simplemente el mal externo, sino la voz interior que siembra sospecha sobre Dios. La tentación comienza cuando el ser humano deja de confiar y empieza a creer que Dios le está quitando algo. El pecado no es solo desobedecer una norma; es romper una relación. Es querer construir la vida al margen de Dios, y el resultado siempre será la pérdida de la paz, de la claridad y de la armonía interior. San Pablo, en la carta a los Romanos, nos ayuda a comprender que esta herida no es solo un hecho del pasado, sino una realidad que toca cada corazón humano. Pero también anuncia la gran esperanza: así como el pecado entró por uno, la gracia y la vida nueva llegan por uno solo, Jesucristo. Donde abundó el pecado, sobreabundó la gracia. Es decir, Dios no abandona al ser humano en su caída; sale a buscarlo, lo levanta y le ofrece un camino nuevo. El Evangelio nos presenta a Jesús en el desierto, enfrentando la tentación. Él no dialoga con la mentira, no negocia con el mal, no busca soluciones fáciles. Permanece fiel. Y ahí está la clave de la Cuaresma: no se trata solo de dejar cosas externas, sino de aprender a permanecer fieles a Dios en las decisiones concretas de cada día. Las tentaciones de Jesús son también las nuestras: buscar el placer sin límite, el poder sin verdad y el éxito sin Dios. Pero Jesús nos muestra que el ser humano solo encuentra su plenitud cuando confía plenamente en el Padre. Querida familia, la Cuaresma es un combate espiritual. Es el tiempo de recuperar el orden interior, de volver a Dios con sinceridad, de revisar actitudes, decisiones y caminos. No tengamos miedo de reconocer lo que debe cambiar. Dios no nos humilla; Dios nos restaura. Este es el tiempo de volver al corazón, de fortalecer la oración, de practicar el ayuno que libera y la caridad que transforma. Si caminamos con sinceridad estos cuarenta días, no llegaremos a la Pascua siendo los mismos, sino siendo hombres y mujeres renovados, más libres y más conscientes de quién es Dios y quiénes somos nosotros. Our Lady of Peace Parish is pleased to announce the forthcoming Eucharistic Encounter Weekend, scheduled from March 6 to March 8, 2026. In partnership with the Saint Carlo Acutis Shrine of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia, the parish will host the Saint Carlo Acutis International Exhibition of Eucharistic Miracles of the World at Most Precious Blood Church. In preparation for the arrival of Saint Carlo Acutis's holy relics in March, five weeks will be devoted to the study of his life and miracles. The study will utilize the concise biography authored by John Conlin, a member of our parish. *"The more we receive the Eucharist, the more we will become like Jesus, so that on this earth we will have a foretaste of Heaven."* - St. Carlo Acutis.

Miracles attributed to St. Carlo Acutis involve two medically unexplained healings recognized by the Vatican: the 2013 recovery of a Brazilian boy born with a rare pancreatic disorder and the 2022 near-complete recovery of a Costa Rican woman from severe head trauma after a bicycle accident.



The young Brazilian boy, Mattheus Vianna, who suffered from a rare pancreatic disorder, was healed after his mother, a devout Catholic, prayed to Carlo Acutis. He spontaneously recovered, and subsequent medical evaluations confirmed the healing was medically inexplicable, fulfilling the rigorous criteria required by the Church's canonization process. On July 2, 2022, Valeria Valverde, a Costa Rican woman studying in France, suffered near-fatal head injuries from a bicycle fall. Valeria underwent emergency surgery, with little hope of survival. Six days after the accident, her mother prayed at the tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis in Assisi, and the following day Valeria began breathing on her own, slowly regaining movement and speech. A CAT scan revealed that her brain contusion had completely disappeared and she was transferred to a rehabilitation facility.
