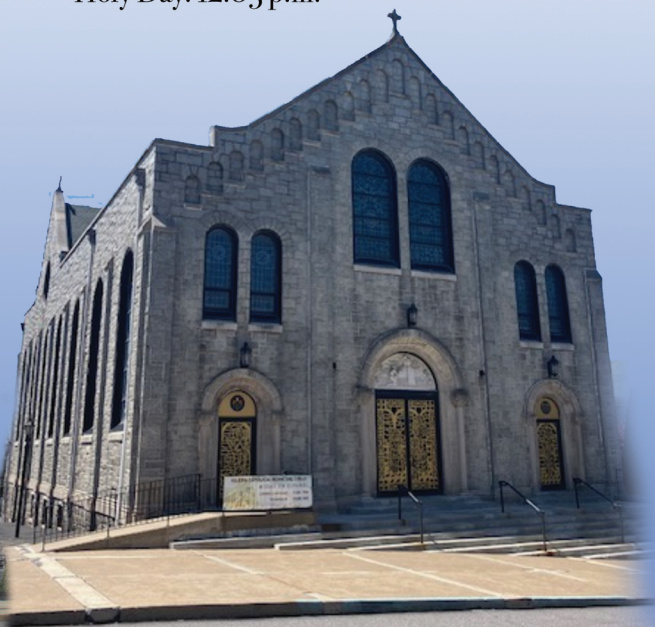

Sacrament of Matrimony: In order to properly prepare for marriage, it is expected that the couple contact the pastor before making other arrangements for the wedding. This initial contact should be at least one year prior to the desired date of marriage.

Sacrament of Baptism: Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays at Our Lady of Grace at 1:00 p.m., and at Most Precious Blood immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass, which parents and Godparents are expected to attend. You must be a registered member of Our Lady of Peace Parish. Godparents must be baptized Catholics who are practicing their faith. Expectant parents are required to receive instruction before the baptism of their child. If you are expecting a child in the next six months, please contact the parish office to register for this instruction.

Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor: It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis.

To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.

PASTOR'S REFLEXIÓN CORNER DEL PASTOR

Dear family of Our Lady of Peace, Jesus invites us to strive to enter the kingdom of heaven. Therefore, forget your concern about whether many or few will enter the kingdom of heaven. Instead, ask yourself: What am I doing to enter the kingdom of heaven?

That person who asked the Lord Jesus Christ if only a few would enter the Kingdom of Heaven seems to have been misinformed. This is what happens to most people; they never go to real and truthful sources. They usually go or have become accustomed to going to the wrong people, who lack knowledge, and with that we realize that they live in an environment that is alien to the truth. This happened today. Nowadays, many people get their information from YouTube, where the informants are people who play on people's ignorance. To this we can add those who marry beliefs and transmit or sell them as revealed truth.

This situation, for example, places me in the Protestant doctrine, which sells the idea that only if you are in their church will you be saved. Remembering what the Mormons and Jehovah's Witnesses preached a few years ago, that only 144,000 would be saved. They stopped preaching that when they realized that their followers had already exceeded that number. But returning to the Lord Jesus, the key is to strive.

Remember that salvation is an open door for everyone, and St. Paul reminds us that God wants all men to be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth. Because salvation is God's will, interest, and initiative. Because God opened the door through his message, passion, crucifixion, death, and resurrection. WHERE THE DOOR IS NARROW, it is to make ourselves small like children and to renounce everything that makes us feel great, so as not to make the mistake of the Pharisee who, in his supposed prayer, said to God: I thank you that I am not like that tax collector. I fast, I pray, I give my tithes. Christ was and is the first to make himself small. LET US NOT FORGET THAT GOD OPENED THE DOOR FOR EVERYONE. It is we who set limits, with our various rejections, indifference, lack of charity, affection, and empathy for others.
