

**Sacrament of Matrimony:** In order to properly prepare for marriage, it is expected that the couple contact the pastor before making other arrangements for the wedding. This initial contact should be at least one year prior to the desired date of marriage.

Sacrament of Baptism: Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays at Our Lady of Grace at 1:00 p.m., and at Most Precious Blood immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass, which parents and Godparents are expected to attend. You must be a registered member of Our Lady of Peace Parish. Godparents must be baptized Catholics who are practicing their faith. Expectant parents are required to receive instruction before the baptism of their child. If you are expecting a child in the next six months, please contact the parish office to register for this instruction.

Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor: It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis.

To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.



Dear family, blessings to all. The first reading speaks to us with great determination, with a spirit totally foreign to what the world tells us



That is why it is necessary that every time you want to practice generosity, you do not do so with pride, because you are allowing evil to take root in your heart. Today we witness how the Lord Jesus himself encountered a situation that is still so relevant today, where people approach you, observe you, and listen to you, but not to do good, but entirely to do you harm. Because they have a purpose, which is to destroy you, like all servants, in order to look good to their master. Even in church it happens; many go to criticize and not to grow and learn to serve.

We must recognize and be grateful for the place God has given us. Not like the experience of the Gospel today. They sought the highest places. Because they suffered from the need to be admired. In their opinion, they felt they were Light, that they had to be placed on high. But the truth is that, instead of illuminating, they caused darkness or at least shadows.

God has a place where he wants us to be. Bearing the fruits that he has planned for us with his grace. So let us be clear, at God's table, there is room for all of us. Not only your parents, siblings, and friends. But also, those whom we have often, perhaps voluntarily or involuntarily, are not accepted. When we do not do things out of goodwill and charity, we demand everything, nothing is free. That is why the Lord proposes a simple condition: do not invite those who can pay or repay you, but those who can only truly thank you and pray but will not reciprocate materially.

And the Lord concludes that He will reward us with the resurrection of the righteous, and I repeat, in the resurrection of the righteous. So let us not be anxious. For what the Lord will reward cannot be seen with the eyes or touched with the hands of clay. But in the resurrection, where the only thing you will find in the resurrection will be what you have done and given with love, because everything you have kept will remain.


