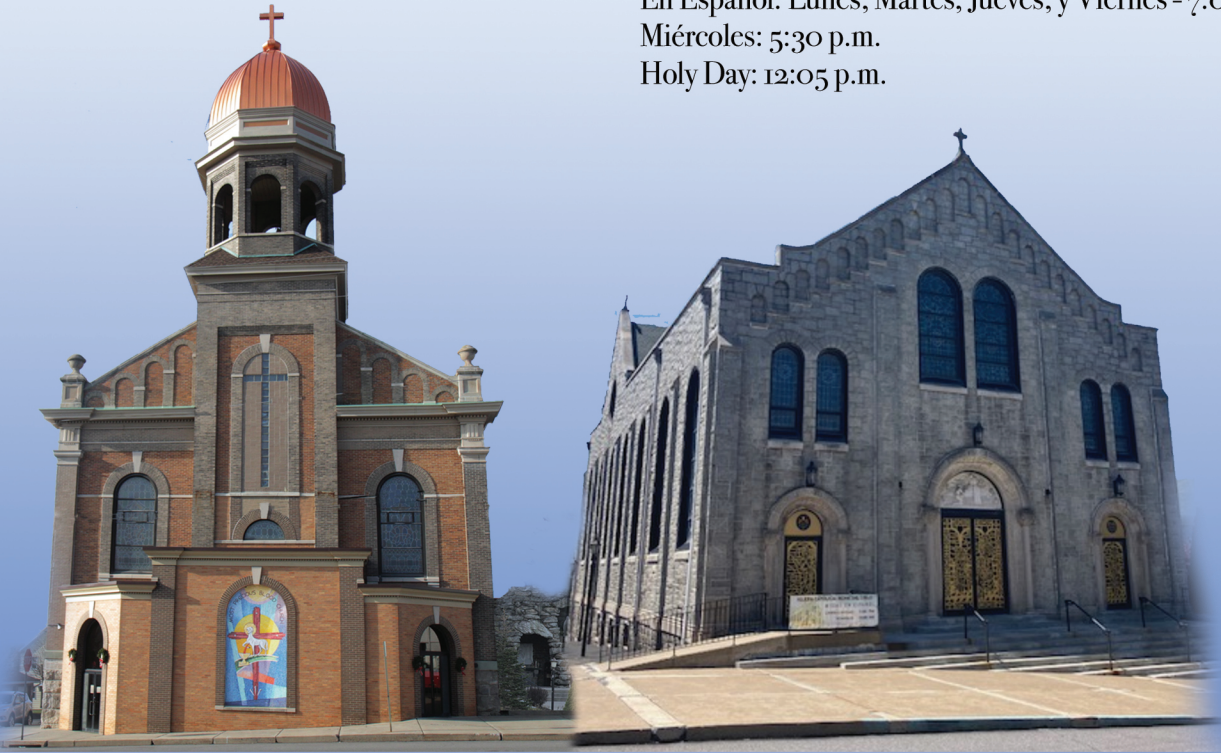

**Sacrament of Matrimony:** In order to properly prepare for marriage, it is expected that the couple contact the pastor before making other arrangements for the wedding. This initial contact should be at least one year prior to the desired date of marriage.

**Sacrament of Baptism:** Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays at Our Lady of Grace at 1:00 p.m., and at Most Precious Blood immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass, which parents and Godparents are expected to attend. You must be a registered member of Our Lady of Peace Parish. Godparents must be baptized Catholics who are practicing their faith. Expectant parents are required to receive instruction before the baptism of their child. If you are expecting a child in the next six months, please contact the parish office to register for this instruction.

**Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor:** It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at [www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis](http://www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis).

To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.

Over the last several weeks, we have looked at financial and parish life trends, which are two of the priority drivers taken into consideration when determining the future of Our Lady of Grace Church. This week we will look at facility costs. Just like the homes we live in, our church “homes” cost money to operate. In fact, our parish spends around \$1300 each week just to keep the doors of Our Lady of Grace facilities open. This breakdown gives an idea of our expenses last year.

The church building of Our Lady of Grace also has significant repair costs. Those who have been parishioners for many years will agree that this is not a new problem, but it is a problem that is ours to deal with now, with Bishop’s request for a recommendation about the future of the church.

Last year, Quandel Energy Solutions was contracted to provide an objective, outside expert Facility Needs Assessment, which estimates \$3,620,200 in repairs to the church building over the next 10 years. The immediate need – over the next 3 years – is \$2,486,700. This independent study details repairing the coping stones, parapet walls and finials, upgrading flashing, replacing caulking and repointing where necessary, and replacing the cupola, among other repairs.

As we look to the future with hope, we must determine our best chance as a healthy, vibrant community, spreading the Gospel, calling forth vocations and caring for those in need. I ask for your continued prayers as we discern God’s will considering the challenges we face. May His will be done.

Querida familia de Nuestra Señora de la Paz; En este Segundo Domingo de Cuaresma, la Palabra de Dios nos presenta una verdad fundamental: Dios llama, Dios transforma y Dios revela.

La primera lectura nos muestra el momento en que Dios le dice a Abraham: “Sal de tu tierra, de tu patria y de la casa de tu padre, hacia la tierra que te mostraré” (Gn 12,1). Este llamado no es sólo geográfico, es existencial. Dios no solo le pide cambiar de lugar, le pide cambiar de vida. Le pide dejar seguridades, dejar el pasado, dejar aquello que le daba identidad, para aprender a vivir desde la confianza.

Y esta es también la esencia de la Cuaresma: Dios nos llama a salir. Salir de nuestras comodidades, de nuestras resistencias, de nuestros pecados, de nuestras excusas, y caminar hacia la vida nueva que Él quiere regalarnos. San Pablo, en la segunda carta a Timoteo, nos recuerda que este llamado no depende de nuestros méritos, sino de la gracia de Dios, que nos ha sido dada en Cristo Jesús. Es Dios quien toma la iniciativa. Es Dios quien nos llama. Es Dios quien nos ofrece una vida nueva. Pero nosotros debemos responder.

El Evangelio nos presenta la Transfiguración del Señor. Jesús sube al monte con Pedro, Santiago y Juan, y allí se transfigura delante de ellos. Su rostro brilla, sus vestiduras se vuelven resplandecientes, y los discípulos contemplan por un instante su verdadera identidad.

¿Por qué ocurre esto en medio del camino hacia la cruz? Porque Dios sabe que el ser humano necesita experimentar la luz, para poder atravesar la oscuridad.

La Transfiguración no elimina la cruz, pero la ilumina. No quita el sufrimiento, pero le da sentido. No evita el camino difícil, pero revela que ese camino conduce a la gloria.

Muchas veces nosotros también vivimos momentos de oscuridad, de confusión, de pruebas, de decepciones. Y podemos preguntarnos: ¿Dónde está Dios?

La respuesta del Evangelio es clara: Dios sigue allí, aunque no lo veamos como quisiéramos. Porque la fe no consiste en ver siempre la luz, sino en confiar incluso cuando caminamos en la sombra.

La voz del Padre dice: “Este es mi Hijo amado, escúchenlo.” Este es el corazón de la Cuaresma: volver a escuchar a Cristo.

Escucharlo por encima de nuestras emociones.

Escucharlo por encima de nuestras heridas.

Escucharlo por encima de nuestras resistencias.

Porque solo cuando escuchamos a Cristo, nuestra vida comienza a transformarse.

Abraham escuchó y su vida cambió.

*“When we face the sun, we get a tan, but when we stand before Jesus in the Eucharist we become saints.”* St. Carlo Acutis

Carlo’s devotion to the Eucharist and these attributed miracles led to his beatification in October 2020. Pope Francis officially approved this second miracle and approved his canonization as the first millennial saint. Pope Francis proclaimed “His witness show’s today’s young people that true happiness is found by putting God first and serving Him in our brothers, especially the least.”



The body of St. Carlo Acutis is not considered incorrupt in the traditional sense, though it is remarkably preserved. Since his body had started to decompose, a wax layer was applied to his face and hands to resemble how he looked before burial. He is displayed in jeans and a pair of Nikes, the casual clothes he preferred in life.

Carlo was canonized alongside Pier Giorgio Frassati by Pope Leo XIV on September 7, 2025. They are the first new saints declared under his pontificate.

Carlo is not the youngest saint to be canonized. That honor belongs to Jacinta Marto and Francisco Marto, Portuguese siblings who witnessed the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima in 1917. They died at ages 9 and 10, respectively. They were canonized by Pope Francis on May 13, 2017, the 100th anniversary of the first apparition of Our Lady of Fatima. The feast day of Saint Carlo Acutis is October 12th.

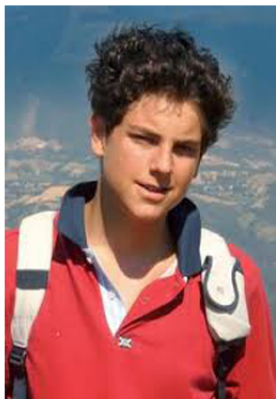
