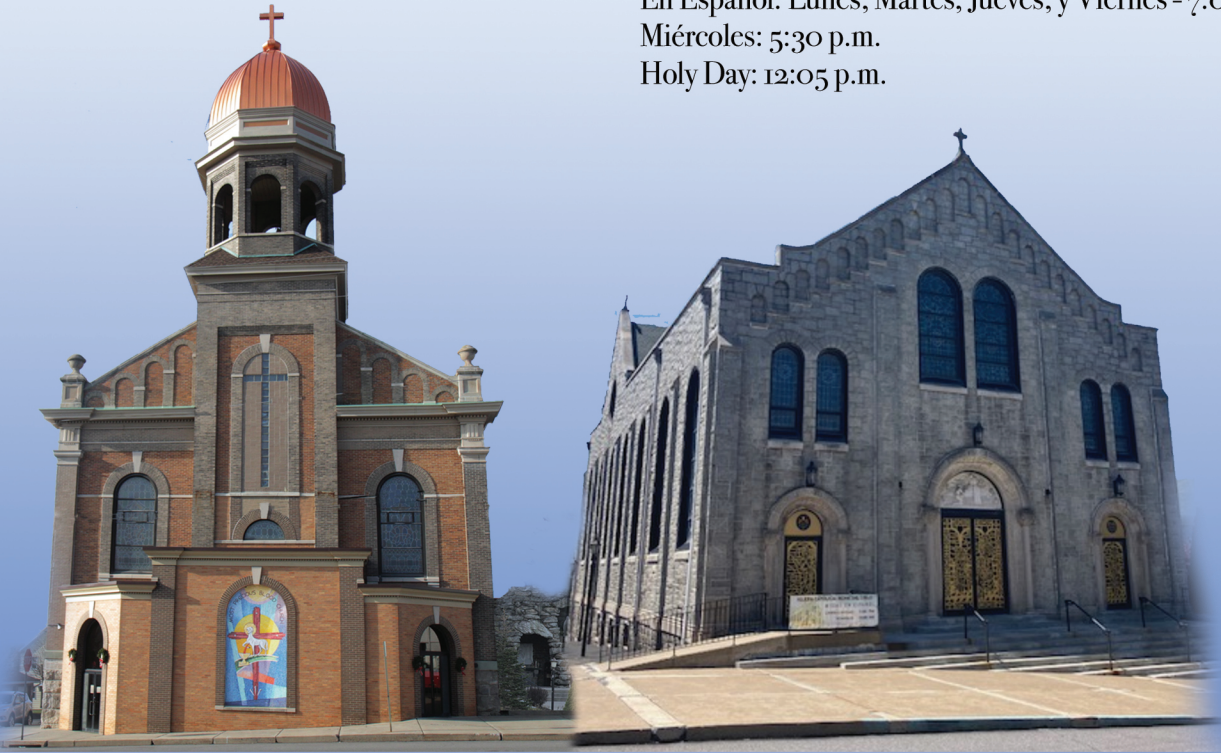

Sacrament of Matrimony: In order to properly prepare for marriage, it is expected that the couple contact the pastor before making other arrangements for the wedding. This initial contact should be at least one year prior to the desired date of marriage.

Sacrament of Baptism: Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays at Our Lady of Grace at 1:00 p.m., and at Most Precious Blood immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass, which parents and Godparents are expected to attend. You must be a registered member of Our Lady of Peace Parish. Godparents must be baptized Catholics who are practicing their faith. Expectant parents are required to receive instruction before the baptism of their child. If you are expecting a child in the next six months, please contact the parish office to register for this instruction.

Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor: It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis.

To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.

Last Sunday was Father's Day and I took the opportunity to have the weekend off from my pastoral duties. As you can see from the announcement in today's bulletin about the new Mass schedule for the City of Hazleton, it may be harder to come by opportunities like that in the future. Anyway, I attended Mass in the area and heard a very good homily for sure. The homilist began by remembering to the fathers gathered for worship that Saint Joseph is our big intercessor on this holiday. He also mentioned he wondered if Mary ever said to Jesus, "Wait until your father gets home." We all chuckled and I continued to muse about what Jesus would have said in reply to his mother if she had ever said that to him.

I remember what he said to Mary and Joseph when he was 12 and lost in Jerusalem. Jesus' reply was "Why were you looking for me? Didn't you know I had to be in my Father's house?"

On another occasion, he would say to his disciples, "If you have seen me, you have seen the Father."

Now, when a mother says to her daughter or son, "Wait until your father gets home," it usually means the child must be disciplined. The connotation is someone is going to get it because someone is in trouble. Well, I guess in a certain sense we were in trouble because of our sinful ways. So, by sending Jesus, who is the image of the Father, we got some discipline. But the discipline we got was not punishment for the wrongdoing as the saying "Wait until your father gets home," connotes. What we received from Jesus is closer to what discipline means, that is, to learn a lesson. And disciples, those in Jesus' day and us too, are active learners. Jesus taught many lessons about staying on the right path and knowing which ones not to travel. The greatest lesson we have learned though is that we didn't receive the punishment. Jesus, the Father's Son and our brother, took the punishment we all deserved. Now, moms and dads, try to remember that when we have to say, "Wait until your father gets home," the occasion is a teachable moment for the child. It's not only about punishment because any punishment should be about learning a lesson. And don't forget, if Jesus took the rap for you and me, don't come down so hard on your child such that the lesson gets lost on your child who is your very own disciple in the Lord.

La Palabra de Dios de este XIII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario nos invita a reflexionar sobre la radicalidad del seguimiento de Jesucristo. En el Evangelio, el Señor nos presenta palabras exigentes: «El que ama a su padre o a su madre más que a mí, no es digno de mí». Jesús no nos pide dejar de amar a nuestra familia; nos enseña que Dios debe ocupar el primer lugar en nuestro corazón. Cuando Cristo es el centro de nuestra vida, aprendemos a amar mejor a todos los demás.

La primera lectura nos presenta a la mujer de Sunem, quien reconoce en el profeta Eliseo a un hombre de Dios y le abre las puertas de su hogar con generosidad. Su hospitalidad no nace del interés ni de la conveniencia, sino de una fe sincera que sabe descubrir la presencia de Dios en medio de la vida cotidiana. Como recompensa, el Señor bendice abundantemente a esta familia. La Palabra nos recuerda que cada gesto de acogida, servicio y caridad realizado por amor a Dios nunca queda sin fruto.

San Pablo, en la carta a los Romanos, nos lleva a contemplar el significado profundo de nuestro Bautismo. Por él hemos sido incorporados a la muerte y resurrección de Cristo. El cristiano no está llamado simplemente a cumplir algunas normas religiosas; está llamado a vivir una vida nueva. Hemos muerto al pecado para caminar en la libertad de los hijos de Dios. Cada día debemos renovar esta identidad bautismal, dejando atrás aquello que nos aleja del Señor y abrazando una existencia marcada por la fe, la esperanza y la caridad. Finalmente, Jesús nos recuerda que incluso el más pequeño acto de amor realizado por causa del Evangelio tiene un valor inmenso ante Dios. «Quien dé un vaso de agua fresca a uno de estos pequeños por ser discípulo, no quedará sin recompensa». En una cultura que muchas veces busca reconocimiento y prestigio, Cristo nos enseña que los gestos sencillos, ocultos y humildes poseen una grandeza eterna cuando nacen del amor. Que esta Eucaristía nos ayude a renovar nuestra decisión de poner a Cristo en el centro de nuestra vida, vivir con fidelidad las gracias de nuestro Bautismo y servir generosamente a los demás, descubriendo en cada persona el rostro mismo del Señor.

Que María Santísima nos enseñe a seguir a Jesús con un corazón indiviso y fiel.
