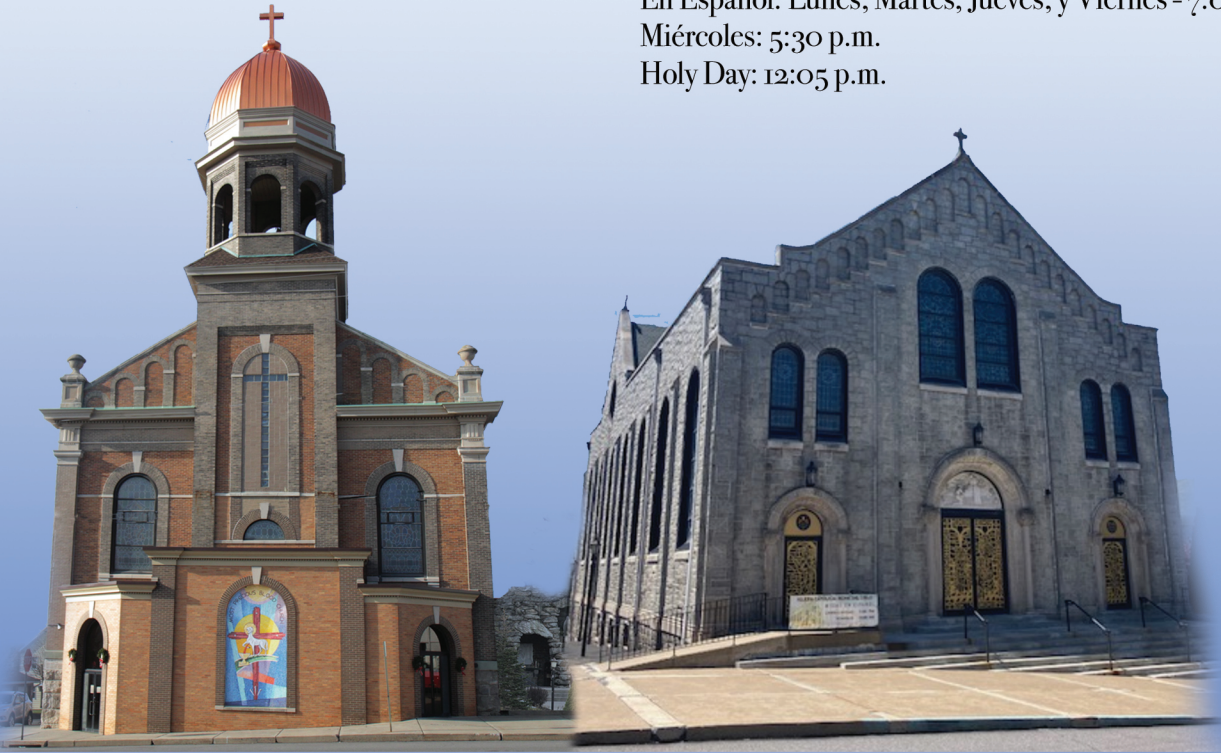

**Sacrament of Matrimony:** In order to properly prepare for marriage, it is expected that the couple contact the pastor before making other arrangements for the wedding. This initial contact should be at least one year prior to the desired date of marriage.

**Sacrament of Baptism:** Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays at Our Lady of Grace at 1:00 p.m., and at Most Precious Blood immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass, which parents and Godparents are expected to attend. You must be a registered member of Our Lady of Peace Parish. Godparents must be baptized Catholics who are practicing their faith. Expectant parents are required to receive instruction before the baptism of their child. If you are expecting a child in the next six months, please contact the parish office to register for this instruction.

**Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor:** It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at [www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis](http://www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis).

To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.

One of the most beautiful ritual celebrations of the Catholic Church during Holy Week is the Chrism Mass. I really cannot say whether the Chrism Mass is something that captures the attention of most Catholics in any diocese or archdiocese. I can say that the Chrism Mass on Tuesday, March 31st, at Saint Peter's Cathedral in Scranton was a standing-room-only congregation made up of a broad demographic.

The special beauty of the Chrism Mass derives from a couple of unique reasons no matter where it is celebrated. For one, the Chrism Mass celebrated in one's own local church, that is his or her diocese or archdiocese, derives its special beauty from the warmth of familiarity. The Chrism Mass joins the faithful around their bishop, together with clergy, religious and laity in a familiarity that forms the bond of unity. I personally became joyfully moved to tears as I entered and exited the cathedral on Tuesday afternoon. Except for when I was studying abroad, I've attended the Chrism Mass in Scranton every year in the last 27 years. Entering, I remembered processing into the Cathedral of Saint Peter almost 27 years ago to be ordained a Catholic priest. When exiting, it was once again the acclaim of the faithful, expressed in grand applause, for the priests that once again choked me up. And it's not just the location that stirs me, though that is a very important part of the experience. Indeed, if the location of the Chrism Mass were other than the Cathedral of Saint Peter, I would still be so moved, because the spirit of unity created by the bonds of charity transcends time and place. That is proven in the fact that 27 years ago it was a different bishop who ordained me, a different gathering of the faithful gathered to celebrate and a different group of priests as well. Another unique reason for the beauty of the Chrism Mass is the consecration of the Holy Oils, namely, the Oil of the Sick, the Oil of Catechumens and Sacred Chrism by the bishop. I'm not sure if it occurs to most Catholics, but the sacramental elements used in the celebration of the Sacraments are renewed during Holy Week liturgies. That's why there is no holy water in the fonts on Holy Thursday and Good Friday. Neither are there any candles alight in candle racks which typically illuminate the darkness of a vacant church building, nor consecrated oils in the Ambry. Almost every sacred sign used in the Sacraments is renewed, especially at the Easter Vigil. And those consecrated oils garnered from the Chrism Mass are the signs used throughout the year by the priest, when he anoints the sick and dying, when he baptizes the catechumen or newborn child, or confirms a youth or someone in danger of death who desires to be in full communion with the Catholic Church.

Querida familia de Nuestra Señora de la Paz: ¡Cristo ha resucitado!, ¡verdaderamente ha resucitado! Con profunda alegría pascual les felicitamos y abrazamos en este día que transforma la historia y renueva nuestra vida. No celebramos una idea ni un recuerdo, sino un acontecimiento real: Dios ha irrumpido en la muerte y la ha vencido para siempre. La Palabra proclamada hoy nos sitúa ante el corazón mismo de nuestra fe. En los Hechos de los Apóstoles (10,34a.37-43), Pedro no predica teorías, sino testimonio: “nosotros somos testigos”. Ha visto, ha comido con Él después de la resurrección, ha sido alcanzado por esa Vida nueva. La fe cristiana no nace de una suposición, sino de un encuentro que transforma. Por eso, la Iglesia no anuncia una doctrina fría, sino una experiencia viva: Cristo vive, y su vida se nos ha comunicado. San Pablo, en la carta a los Colosenses (3,1-4), nos lleva más profundo: “busquen los bienes de arriba”. La resurrección no es solo un hecho que contemplamos, sino una vida que asumimos. Hemos resucitado con Cristo. Esto implica un cambio radical de mirada, de criterios, de deseos. Ya no vivimos anclados en lo pasajero, en lo superficial o en lo que perece, sino en aquello que tiene sabor de eternidad. Nuestra vida está “escondida con Cristo en Dios”, y eso redefine nuestras decisiones, nuestras luchas y nuestras esperanzas. El Evangelio de San Juan (20,1-9) nos presenta el camino de la fe pascual: ver y creer. El sepulcro vacío no impone, sino que invita. Juan entra, ve y cree. Pedro entra, observa, y comienza un proceso. María Magdalena corre, busca, anuncia. Cada uno recorre su propio itinerario hacia la fe. Así también nosotros: la resurrección no se impone por la fuerza, se acoge desde un corazón que se deja interpelar. Dios no violenta; revela. Y en esa revelación, espera nuestra respuesta. La reflexión de nuestros exegetas nos recuerda que la Pascua no es un punto final, sino un comienzo. Si Cristo ha resucitado, entonces nuestra vida no puede seguir igual. La fe verdadera se convierte en testimonio concreto: en la forma de amar, de perdonar, de levantarnos después de caer, de sostener al que está herido, de permanecer fieles incluso cuando no somos correspondidos. La resurrección se hace visible en una vida transformada. Hoy, más que nunca, el mundo necesita testigos. No bastan palabras; hacen falta vidas que hablen. Personas que puedan decir, como Pedro: “yo lo he visto”, no solo con los ojos, sino con la existencia. Porque quien ha experimentado al Resucitado no puede callar, no puede vivir igual, no puede esconder lo que ha recibido. Familia querida, Dios, la historia y la misma Palabra esperan de nosotros ese compromiso de vida: transmitir lo que hemos escuchado, lo que hemos visto y lo que hemos vivido. La Pascua nos envía. No somos espectadores de la resurrección, somos portadores de ella. Que esta celebración no se quede en un momento, sino que se convierta en un estilo de vida. Que donde haya tristeza, llevemos esperanza; donde haya muerte, anunciemos vida; donde haya oscuridad, encendamos la luz de Cristo. ¡Feliz Pascua de Resurrección!
