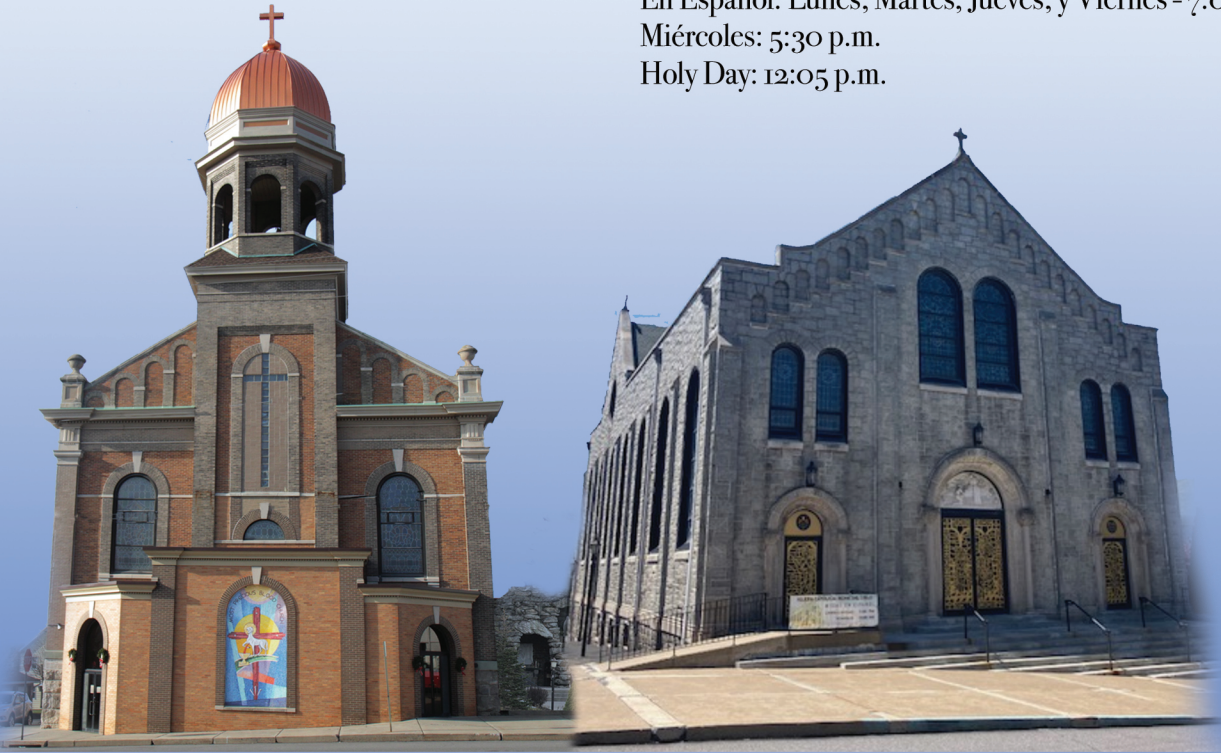

Sacrament of Matrimony: In order to properly prepare for marriage, it is expected that the couple contact the pastor before making other arrangements for the wedding. This initial contact should be at least one year prior to the desired date of marriage.

Sacrament of Baptism: Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays at Our Lady of Grace at 1:00 p.m., and at Most Precious Blood immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass, which parents and Godparents are expected to attend. You must be a registered member of Our Lady of Peace Parish. Godparents must be baptized Catholics who are practicing their faith. Expectant parents are required to receive instruction before the baptism of their child. If you are expecting a child in the next six months, please contact the parish office to register for this instruction.

Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor: It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis.

To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.

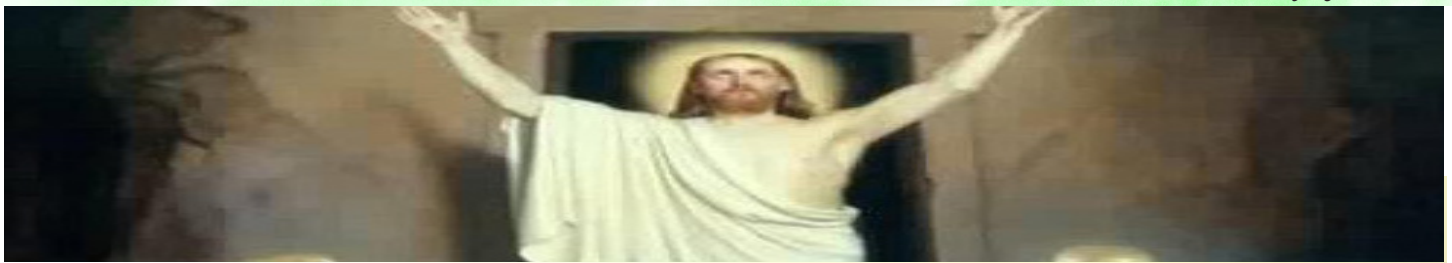

REFLEXIÓN DEL PASTOR ASSISTANT PASTOR



On the evening of Wednesday, April 15, 2026, a town hall meeting was held to review all the drivers involving a very difficult recommendation to Bishop Bambara regarding Our Lady of Grace church. Soon, Bishop will receive a letter from me recommending we close Our Lady of Grace church on August 2, 2026.

I want you to know this has been a very difficult and painful decision and I realize that this news is even more shocking and emotionally charged for the parishioners who know Our Lady of Grace church as their "home away from home" for many, many years. A great deal of memories comprises a wealth of sentimental treasures for more families than I know. A year ago, we faced the challenge of consolidating Most Precious Blood and Queen of Heaven parishes. Clearly, the consolidation news sent shock waves through both parish communities because it meant a threat of identity loss both personal and communal. That's a very real thing for everyone to process. A great deal of emotions, mostly negative, take over. And each person reacts to it differently. It was important, however, that we look intelligently and reasonably at the present situation and move forward with the task entrusted to us. I believe we've consolidated successfully. But we also had to make a recommendation concerning Our Lady of Grace church. One of the first challenges I faced, after the consolidation, was to form a financial and pastoral council to assist me. Parishioners from both parishes took up my invitation to lead the parish in this way and at Wednesday's presentation, given by some members of the pastoral and finance team, they showed they also understood the real loss of identity for everyone. The parish leadership team demonstrated their intention that everyone is respected, received, and heard. I have great affection for the parish leadership team because they understand the pain themselves.

Shortly, Bishop Bambara will receive the letter of recommendation from me. I expect to hear from Bishop regarding the recommendation. Should Bishop Bambara agree with our recommendation, he will bring the recommendation to the Diocesan Presbyteral Council in May. At that time, each priest on the Council will hear about the proposed relegation and ask me questions for clarification if necessary before they each priest votes on the relegation. The intervention of each priest will be recorded and then Bishop Bambara will be free to decide regarding the recommendation. After that, an official legal document called a decree will be issued and released to the public. The decree will include the date of relegation of the church to profane but not sordid use. The church will remain open until August 2, 2026 at which time a closing Mass will be celebrated.

Querida familia de Nuestra Señora de la Paz: En este Cuarto Domingo de Pascua, conocido como el Domingo del Buen Pastor, la Palabra de Dios nos conduce al corazón mismo de nuestra fe: Cristo, Pastor verdadero, que no solo guía, sino que entrega su vida por sus ovejas. En esta jornada de oración por las vocaciones, la Iglesia nos invita a escuchar con mayor profundidad esa voz que llama, que reúne y que envía. En los Hechos de los Apóstoles (2,14.36-41), Pedro se levanta con autoridad y anuncia sin temor que Jesús, a quien fue crucificado, ha sido constituido Señor y Mesías. Este anuncio no deja indiferente: "se les traspasó el corazón". La verdadera predicación toca, hiere, despierta. Y ante esa herida nace la pregunta decisiva: "¿Qué tenemos que hacer?" La respuesta no es superficial: conversión, bautismo, vida nueva. Así actúa el Buen Pastor: no adormece, no entretiene, sino que despierta la conciencia y conduce a una decisión concreta. Toda vocación nace de un corazón que ha sido tocado y que responde. La primera carta de Pedro (2,20-25) nos presenta a Cristo como el Pastor que carga con nuestras heridas. Él no respondió con violencia, no devolvió insulto por insulto, sino que se entregó, confiando en el Padre. "Por sus heridas han sido sanados." Aquí se revela el estilo del verdadero pastor: no dominar, sino servir; no imponerse, sino entregarse. Y en ese camino, cada vocación encuentra su forma: el sacerdote, el consagrado, el matrimonio, la vida entregada en medio del mundo... todos llamados a reproducir ese amor que sana, que sostiene y que permanece fiel incluso en el sufrimiento. En el Evangelio de San Juan (10,1-10), Jesús se presenta como la puerta del redil. No es un pastor lejano, es el acceso mismo a la vida. "Yo he venido para que tengan vida y la tengan en abundancia." Pero también advierte: hay ladrones y salteadores, voces que no conducen a la vida, caminos que dispersan y destruyen. Por eso, discernir la voz del Pastor es vital. La vocación no nace del ruido, sino de la escucha. No surge de la confusión, sino de la intimidad con Cristo. Hoy, más que nunca, necesitamos pedir por las vocaciones. No como una idea abstracta, sino como una urgencia concreta de la Iglesia. Dios sigue llamando, pero es necesario un corazón disponible, una comunidad que acompañe y un ambiente donde la voz de Cristo pueda ser escuchada sin interferencias. Cada uno de nosotros tiene responsabilidad: orar, sostener, promover, y sobre todo vivir de tal manera que otros puedan descubrir en nuestra vida el rostro del Buen Pastor.

Este domingo es también una llamada personal: ¿a qué me está llamando Cristo? ¿Estoy escuchando su voz o estoy distraído por otras voces? ¿Estoy dispuesto a dejarme conducir, incluso cuando el camino exige renuncia y entrega?

El Buen Pastor no abandona. Sigue buscando, sigue llamando, sigue tocando el corazón. Que no endurezcamos el oído. Que no pospongamos la respuesta. Porque solo en Él encontramos la vida verdadera, la vida en abundancia.
