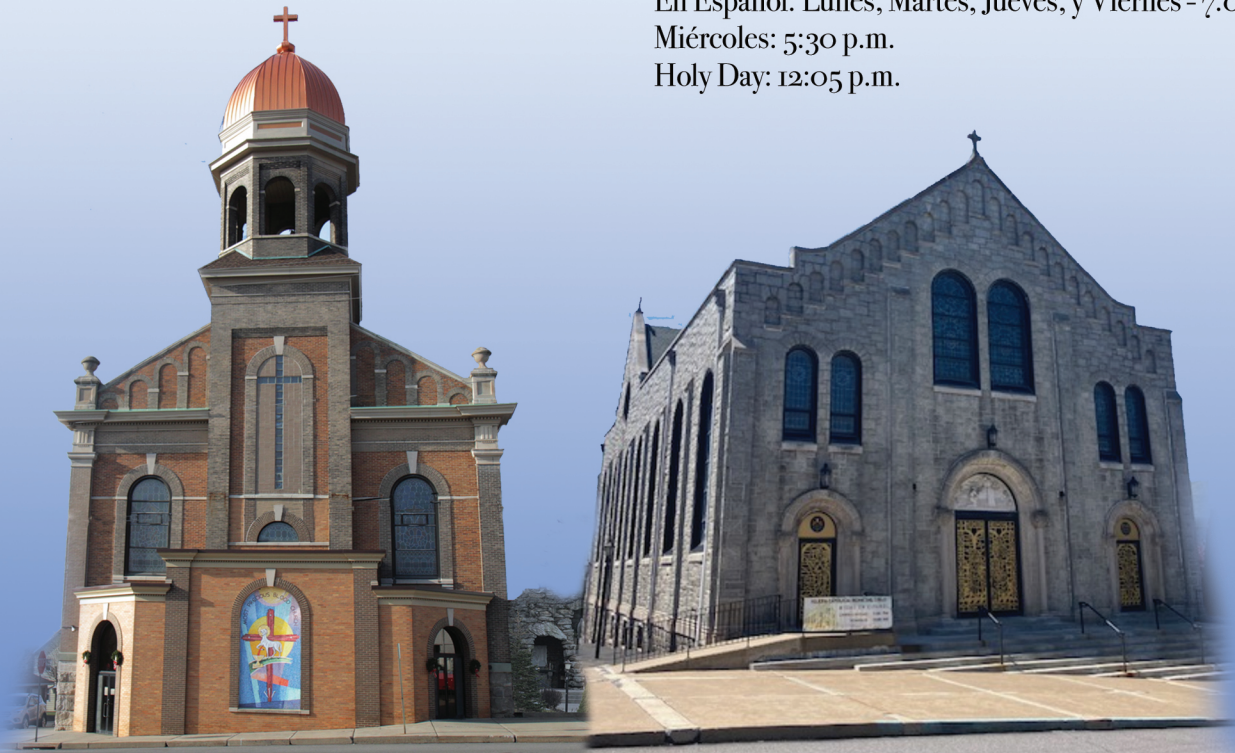

**CCD Classes:** are held every Sunday morning from 8:45 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. at Most Precious Blood.

**Sacrament of Matrimony:** In order to properly prepare for marriage, it is expected that the couple contact the pastor before making other arrangements for the wedding. This initial contact should be at least one year prior to the desired date of marriage.

**Sacrament of Baptism:** Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays at Our Lady of Grace at 1:00 p.m., and at Most Precious Blood immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass, which parents and Godparents are expected to attend. You must be a registered member of Our Lady of Peace Parish. Godparents must be baptized Catholics who are practicing their faith. Expectant parents are required to receive instruction before the baptism of their child. If you are expecting a child in the next six months, please contact the parish office to register for this instruction.

**Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor:** It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at [www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis](http://www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis).

To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.

Where does the Sacrament of Reconciliation stand in your list of Lenten priorities? Lent is a time for penitential practices which lead to a personal renunciation of sin called repentance. And so, getting to Confession should be high on the list of Lenten priorities. Unfortunately, many Catholics do not return to the Lord through the Sacrament of Confession because in a pluralistic society founded on absolute individualism, people believe they can go directly to God. They do not see the need to confess their sins to a priest and, thereby, receive absolution. After all, where does it say I have to confess to a priest? Saint Paul, one of the bible's biggest sinners before his conversion to Christ, writes to the church in Corinth, "All this is from God, who has reconciled us to himself through Christ and given us the ministry of reconciliation. ..." (2 Cor. 5:18). Not only is sacramental reconciliation cited in the bible, but Saint Paul also tells us the Sacrament of Reconciliation is from God through Christ. The message entrusted to the apostles is reconciliation, as Saint Paul says in verse 19. "So, we are ambassadors for Christ, as if God were appealing through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God." (2 Cor. 5:20) The message would not be efficacious, however, if the authority to forgive sins were not granted by Christ to Peter and the Apostles, and subsequently, to the Pope and the Bishops in communion with him. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states, "During his public life Jesus not only forgave sins but also made plain the effect of this forgiveness: he reintegrated forgive sinners into the community of the People of God from which sin had alienated or even excluded them." (CCC, 1443).

This uncovers the roots of error. Moral rectitude is not a personal affair between me and the Lord. Such thinking exposes the sinner who is only hiding behind the cross of Christ.

When we expose ourselves to judgment in the sacrament of Confession, we come from behind the cross to look into the eyes of the suffering, sinless Christ who "died for the sins of the whole world." The people which stand in front of the cross of Christ is his Church. "In imparting to his apostles his own power to forgive sins the Lord also gives them the authority to reconcile sinners with the Church." (CCC 1444).

If our sins wound the Christ of God, it only stands to reason that our sins also would the Church conceived from his pierced side. So, it all makes sense that we only seek forgiveness from those we offend, and in the case of sin, those offended are God AND the Church. Lent is about to conclude so get to confession. Check the bulletin for regular confession times on Saturdays, for the times on Mondays and Tuesdays under the listing of "The Light is on for You" and know that there is an opportunity for confession at Saint John Bosco church in Conyngham on Tuesday, March 24th at 6 pm. Reflexión para el V Domingo de Cuaresma

Las lecturas de este domingo nos colocan frente a una de las revelaciones más profundas de toda la Escritura: Dios no es un Dios de muerte, sino de vida. Cuando todo parece terminado, cuando la esperanza parece sepultada, cuando el corazón humano cree que ya no hay salida, el Señor pronuncia su palabra y abre los sepulcros.

El profeta Ezequiel habla a un pueblo derrotado, exiliado y sin esperanza. Israel se sentía como un cementerio: sin futuro, sin fuerza, sin vida. En ese contexto Dios anuncia algo sorprendente: "Abriré sus sepulcros, los sacaré de sus tumbas y pondré mi espíritu en ustedes y vivirán." No se trata solo de una promesa política o histórica, sino de una revelación espiritual profunda. Dios promete una restauración interior, una vida nueva que nace de su Espíritu. Cuando el Espíritu de Dios entra en la existencia humana, incluso lo que parecía muerto comienza a renacer.

San Pablo retoma esta misma verdad y la lleva al corazón de la vida cristiana. El apóstol distingue entre vivir según la carne y vivir según el Espíritu. La carne representa la vida encerrada en sí misma, dominada por el egoísmo, el miedo y el pecado; el Espíritu, en cambio, es la vida abierta a Dios. Pablo afirma algo extraordinario: el mismo Espíritu que resucitó a Cristo de entre los muertos habita en los creyentes. Esto significa que la resurrección no es solo un acontecimiento futuro; es una fuerza que ya actúa en el presente, transformando el interior de quienes permiten que Dios habite en ellos.

El Evangelio presenta uno de los signos más conmovedores de Jesús: la resurrección de Lázaro. No es solamente un milagro, sino una revelación del corazón de Cristo. Jesús llega a Betania y se encuentra con el dolor de Marta y María. El evangelio nos muestra algo profundamente humano: Jesús llora. Dios no es indiferente al sufrimiento humano; participa de él, lo asume y lo transforma. Sin embargo, el relato no se queda en la tristeza. Jesús pronuncia una declaración que atraviesa toda la fe cristiana: "Yo soy la resurrección y la vida; el que cree en mí, aunque muera, vivirá." Luego se acerca al sepulcro y grita: "¡Lázaro, sal fuera!"

Con esa palabra, la muerte pierde su aparente dominio. Este signo anuncia algo mucho más grande: Jesús no solo resucita a un amigo, sino que revela que Él mismo es la Vida que vence definitivamente a la muerte. Por eso, el evangelio también se convierte en una pregunta para cada creyente: ¿qué sepulcros hay en nuestra vida? ¿Qué situaciones, pecados, heridas o desesperanzas nos mantienen encerrados? La Cuaresma nos invita a escuchar la voz de Cristo que sigue diciendo: "Sal fuera." Sal de la resignación, sal del pecado, sal de aquello que te encierra y te roba la vida. Cuando permitimos que la palabra de Cristo nos alcance, el Espíritu vuelve a soplar y lo que parecía muerto comienza a vivir. Así, el camino cuaresmal nos prepara para el gran anuncio de la Pascua: Dios tiene la última palabra, y esa palabra siempre es vida.

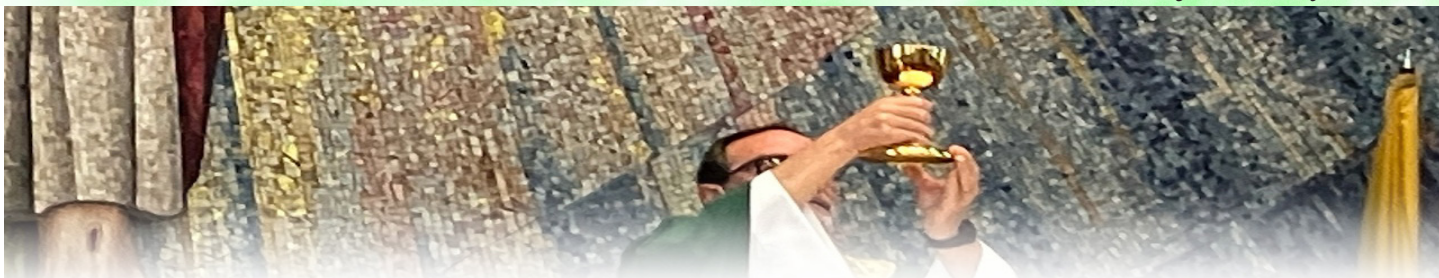
