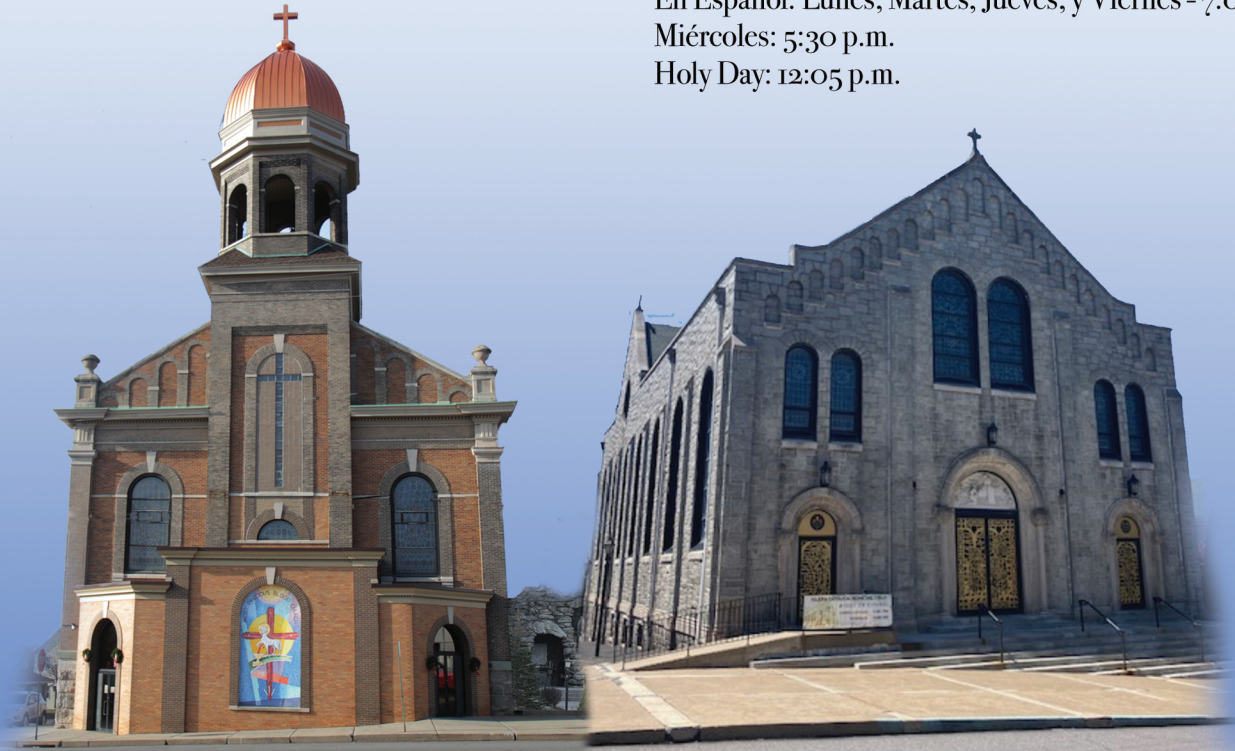

Sacrament of Matrimony: In order to properly prepare for marriage, it is expected that the couple contact the pastor before making other arrangements for the wedding. This initial contact should be at least one year prior to the desired date of marriage.

Sacrament of Baptism: Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays at Our Lady of Grace at 1:00 p.m., and at Most Precious Blood immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass, which parents and Godparents are expected to attend. You must be a registered member of Our Lady of Peace Parish. Godparents must be baptized Catholics who are practicing their faith. Expectant parents are required to receive instruction before the baptism of their child. If you are expecting a child in the next six months, please contact the parish office to register for this instruction.

Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor: It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis.

To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.

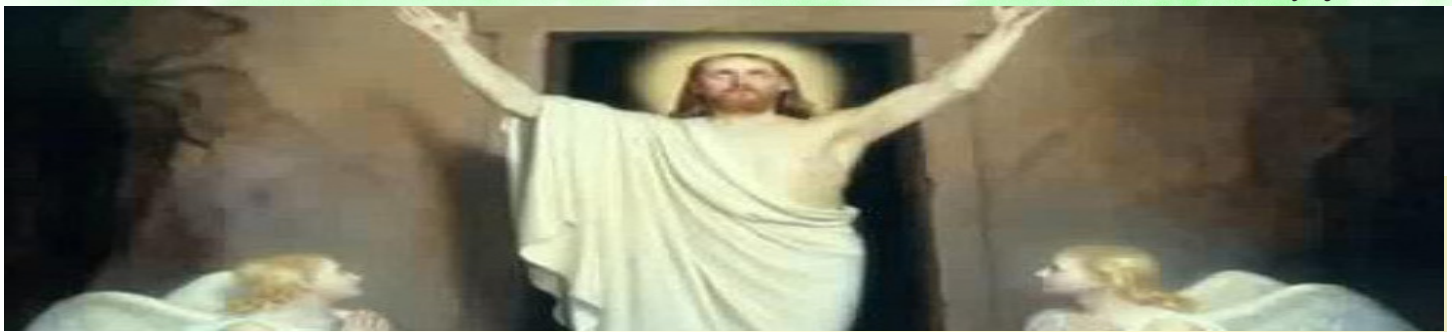

God commanded Moses, “Speak to the whole Israelite community and tell them: Be holy, for I, the Lord, your God am holy.” Without the benefit of technology, how did Moses address the entire community of the Israelites? After all, the Israelites numbered in the thousands!

Using words is one way to communicate, of course. But community identity has a way of communicating all its own. For example, how far reaching and long abiding was the old admonition: Do nothing to bring shame to the family name? Most of us only had to hear our father say it once and it took root in our hearts and guided every decision for the better at any moment. That’s the difference between “being” and “behaving.” What abides in the heart directs every decision to act.

So, when the Lord commanded Moses to “speak” to the whole Israelite community, the mission wasn’t for the word to get out as much as the example to be set. Moses first had to be the leader who was “holy” just as the Lord, his God, is holy. In other words, Moses had to have holiness in his heart first so that he could lead the community by his example. That is exactly how Moses “spoke” to the Israelite community.

Yet, how would you know holiness if you saw it exemplified? The hallmarks of holiness can be summarized in three words: Truth, Love and Life. Jesus said the same thing to Thomas at the Last Supper when he said, “I am the Way (Love), the Truth and the Life. No one comes to the Father except through me.”

Truth is not a commodity to be exploited but a gift to be shared. Love is never a pleasure to be possessed since it is better to give than receive. And Life is not my own to control; it should be lavishly bestowed. Moses was that leader of the Israelite community.

But it the Israelite community became hoy because of Moses. If you consider the 10 Commandments, each one contains all the hallmarks of holiness. If Moses wasn’t first the “holy” leader of the community, the 10 Commandments would never have been accepted among the Israelites. But, as it is, we still talk about the 10 Commandments and memorize them today.
