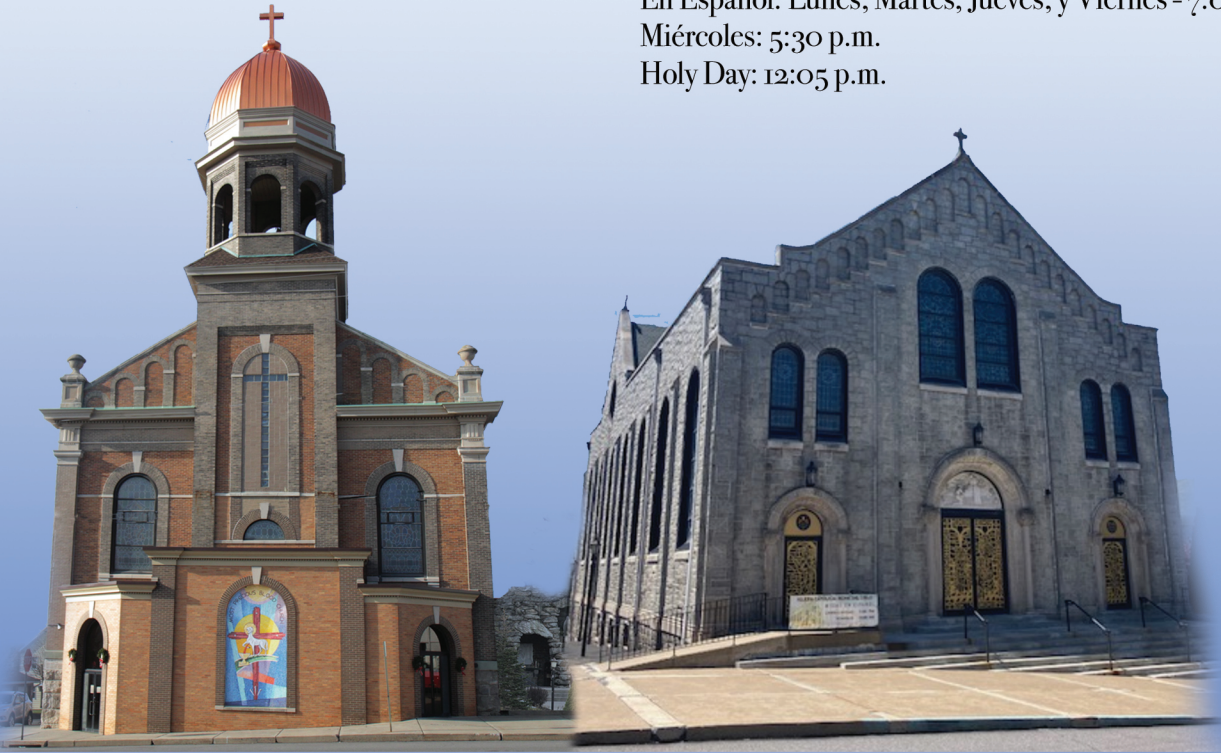

**CCD Classes:** are held every Sunday morning from 8:45 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. at Most Precious Blood.

**Sacrament of Matrimony:** In order to properly prepare for marriage, it is expected that the couple contact the pastor before making other arrangements for the wedding. This initial contact should be at least one year prior to the desired date of marriage.

**Sacrament of Baptism:** Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays at Our Lady of Grace at 1:00 p.m., and at Most Precious Blood immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass, which parents and Godparents are expected to attend. You must be a registered member of Our Lady of Peace Parish. Godparents must be baptized Catholics who are practicing their faith. Expectant parents are required to receive instruction before the baptism of their child. If you are expecting a child in the next six months, please contact the parish office to register for this instruction.

**Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor:** It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at [www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis](http://www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis).

To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.

Durante las últimas semanas, hemos analizado las tendencias financieras y de vida parroquial, que son dos de los factores prioritarios que se toman en consideración al determinar el futuro de la iglesia Nuestra Señora de la Gracia. Esta semana examinaremos los costos de las instalaciones.

Al igual que las casas en las que vivimos, nuestros “hogares” parroquiales requieren recursos para su funcionamiento. De hecho, nuestra parroquia gasta alrededor de 1,300 dólares cada semana solo para mantener abiertas las puertas de las instalaciones de Nuestra Señora de la Gracia. El siguiente desglose ofrece una idea de nuestros gastos del año pasado.

El edificio de la iglesia de Nuestra Señora de la Gracia también presenta costos significativos de reparación. Quienes han sido feligreses durante muchos años estarán de acuerdo en que no se trata de un problema nuevo, pero es un desafío que ahora nos corresponde afrontar, especialmente ante la solicitud del Obispo de presentar una recomendación sobre el futuro de la iglesia.

El año pasado, se contrató a Quandel Energy Solutions para realizar una Evaluación de Necesidades de las Instalaciones, objetiva y realizada por expertos externos, la cual estima \$3,620,200 dólares en reparaciones del edificio de la iglesia durante los próximos 10 años. La necesidad inmediata, en los próximos 3 años, asciende a \$2,486,700 dólares. Este estudio independiente detalla la reparación de las piedras de coronación, los muros de parapeto y los pináculos, la actualización de los remates metálicos (flashing), el reemplazo del sellador y el rejuntado donde sea necesario, así como la sustitución de la cúpula, entre otras reparaciones.

Al mirar hacia el futuro con esperanza, debemos determinar nuestra mejor oportunidad como comunidad sana y vibrante, anunciando el Evangelio, promoviendo las vocaciones y cuidando de los necesitados. Les pido que continúen con sus oraciones mientras discernimos la voluntad de Dios ante los desafíos que enfrentamos. Que se haga Su voluntad.

Querida familia de Nuestra Señora de la Paz:

En este Tercer Domingo de Cuaresma, la Palabra de Dios nos revela una verdad que toca una de las experiencias más profundas del corazón humano: la sed. No se trata solo de la sed física, sino de esa sed interior de sentido, de amor, de fidelidad y de vida verdadera.

En el libro del Éxodo (17,3-7), el pueblo de Israel, en medio del desierto, experimenta la prueba de la escasez y murmura contra Dios. La sed los lleva a dudar y a preguntarse: “¿Está o no está el Señor en medio de nosotros?” Esta pregunta no nace sólo de la garganta seca, sino de un corazón que se siente abandonado. Sin embargo, Dios responde no con reproche, sino con misericordia: hace brotar agua de la roca. Los exegetas nos recuerdan que esa roca es signo de un Dios que permanece fiel incluso cuando el hombre duda, y que es capaz de hacer brotar vida donde parecía imposible.

San Pablo, en la carta a los Romanos (5,1-2.5-8), nos lleva más lejos aún: esa fidelidad de Dios se ha manifestado plenamente en Cristo. Él murió por nosotros cuando aún éramos débiles y pecadores. Esto significa que el amor de Dios no es una recompensa a nuestra perfección, sino un don gratuito que se nos ofrece en nuestra fragilidad. Por eso, nuestra esperanza no defrauda, porque está fundada no en nuestras fuerzas, sino en el amor que Dios ha derramado en nuestros corazones.

Esta verdad alcanza su expresión más conmovedora en el Evangelio de San Juan (4,5-42), en el encuentro de Jesús con la mujer samaritana. Ella llega al pozo con su cántaro, símbolo de sus búsquedas, de sus vacíos y de su historia herida. Jesús, que conoce su sed más profunda, le revela que solo Él puede darle el “agua viva”, esa vida nueva que no se agota y que transforma el corazón. Los exegetas destacan que esta mujer, que había ido a sacar agua, termina convirtiéndose en fuente para otros, porque quien se encuentra verdaderamente con Cristo ya no vive desde su vacío, sino desde la plenitud que ha recibido.

Querida familia, la Cuaresma es el tiempo para reconocer nuestra propia sed y dejar que Cristo llegue a ese lugar de nuestra vida donde hemos buscado en vano. Él sigue esperando junto al pozo de nuestra historia, no para juzgarnos, sino para ofrecernos el agua viva de su amor.

Pidámosle la gracia de no endurecer el corazón, de no quedarnos en la queja ni en la desilusión, sino de abrirnos a su presencia. Porque solo quien bebe de Cristo descubre que su sed más profunda no era una condena, sino el comienzo de un encuentro que puede cambiarlo todo.

**Canonization Timeline:**

- October 12, 2006: Death of Carlo Acutis
- October 12, 2012: The cause for Carlo’s beatification and canonization officially opened, making him a Servant of God
- May 13, 2013: The Holy See issued a Nihil Obstat to the cause of Carlo’s beatification and canonization
- November 24, 2016: The diocesan process for the beatification and canonization of the Servant of God Carlo Acutis concludes
- July 5, 2018: Pope Francis declared Carlo Venerable
- January 23, 2019: Carlo’s body was exhumed
- April 6, 2019: Carlo’s mortal remains were transferred to a sepulchral monument at the Church of Santa Maria Maggiore in Assisi
- October 10, 2020: Carlo was beatified in Assisi
- April 27, 2025: Original date for Carlo’s canonization, postponed due to the death of Pope Francis
- September 7, 2025: Carlo was proclaimed a Saint in St. Peter’s in Rome by Pope Leo XIV
