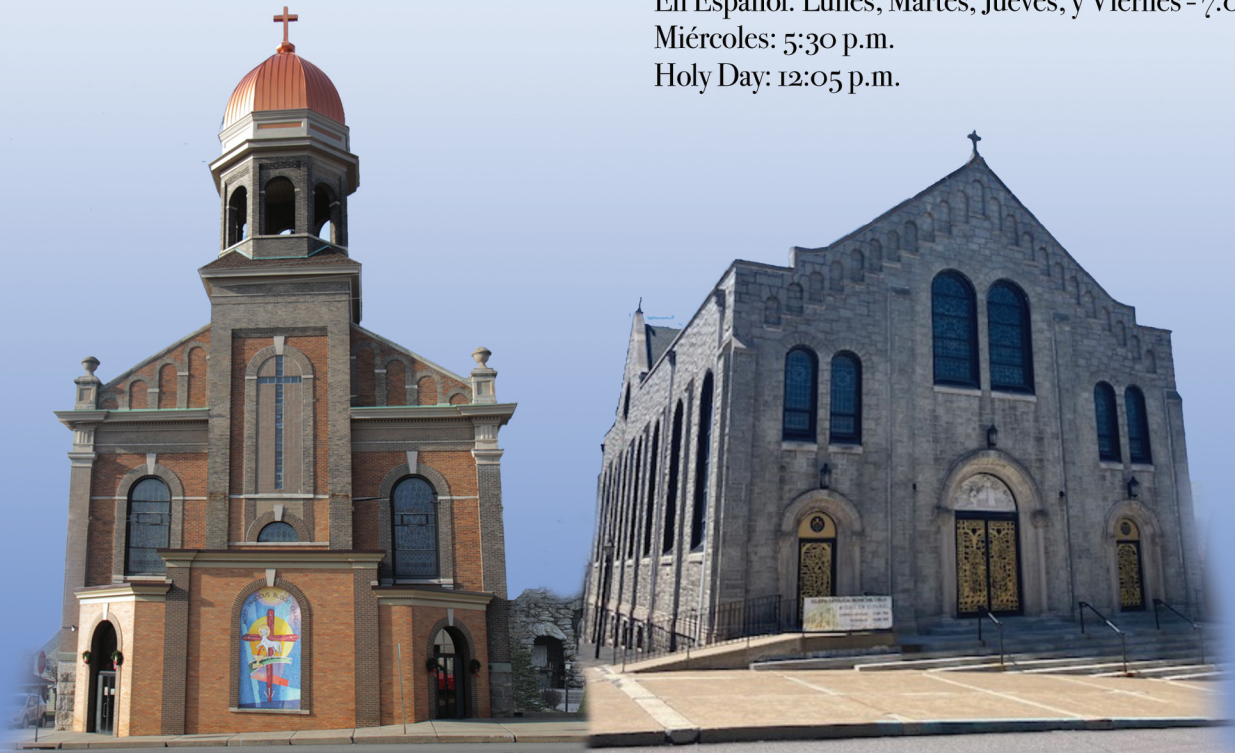

Sacrament of Matrimony: In order to properly prepare for marriage, it is expected that the couple contact the pastor before making other arrangements for the wedding. This initial contact should be at least one year prior to the desired date of marriage.

Sacrament of Baptism: Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays at Our Lady of Grace at 1:00 p.m., and at Most Precious Blood immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass, which parents and Godparents are expected to attend. You must be a registered member of Our Lady of Peace Parish. Godparents must be baptized Catholics who are practicing their faith. Expectant parents are required to receive instruction before the baptism of their child. If you are expecting a child in the next six months, please contact the parish office to register for this instruction.

Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor: It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis.

To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

En la fiesta de la Sagrada Familia, la Iglesia nos invita a contemplar no una familia idealizada o perfecta, sino una familia real, atravesada por la fe, la fragilidad humana y la obediencia confiada a Dios. José, María y el Niño Jesús nos muestran que la santidad no se vive fuera de la historia, sino en medio de ella, en lo cotidiano, en las decisiones difíciles y en el amor perseverante.

La primera lectura, tomada del libro del Eclesiástico, nos recuerda que la familia es el primer espacio donde se aprende a honrar, cuidar y respetar. Honrar al padre y a la madre no es solo un mandato moral, sino una fuente de bendición, de reconciliación interior y de vida larga. Allí donde se cuida a los padres, especialmente en la fragilidad y la vejez, se sana la memoria del corazón y se construye una sociedad más humana. La familia se convierte así en el primer lugar donde se aprende la gratitud, la paciencia y la misericordia.

San Pablo, en la carta a los Colosenses, nos ofrece una verdadera espiritualidad familiar. Nos exhorta a revestirnos de compasión, bondad, humildad, mansedumbre y paciencia. Estas no son virtudes abstractas, sino actitudes concretas que sostienen la vida diaria del hogar. El apóstol sabe que la familia no está exenta de conflictos; por eso insiste en el perdón, en el amor que todo lo une y en la paz que debe reinar en el corazón. Cuando Cristo es el centro del hogar, la autoridad se transforma en servicio, la obediencia en confianza y el amor en entrega mutua.

El Evangelio según san Mateo nos presenta a la Sagrada Familia como una familia migrante, perseguida y vulnerable. José escucha a Dios en sueños y actúa con prontitud para proteger la vida del Niño. No discute, no posterga, no se instala en la comodidad. Se levanta, obedece y confía. María acompaña en silencio y fe. Jesús crece en un ambiente marcado por la inseguridad, el exilio y el trabajo humilde. Así, Dios santifica todas las realidades familiares: el miedo, el desplazamiento, la incertidumbre y el comenzar de nuevo.

Esta fiesta nos recuerda que la familia es un proyecto de Dios y una misión para el mundo. No es solo un espacio privado, sino una verdadera iglesia doméstica, donde se aprende a amar, a perdonar, a servir y a abrirse a los demás. En la familia se custodia la vida, se educa el corazón y se transmite la fe de generación en generación.

Hoy más que nunca, la Sagrada Familia nos llama a proteger la dignidad de la familia, a acompañar a las que sufren, a sostener a las que están heridas y a no perder la esperanza. Allí donde hay amor fiel, oración compartida y confianza en Dios, incluso en medio de la fragilidad, Dios habita y sigue salvando.

Que la Sagrada Familia de Nazaret bendiga nuestros hogares, sane nuestras relaciones y nos enseñe a caminar juntos, con fe, obediencia y amor.
