

**Sacrament of Matrimony:** In order to properly prepare for marriage, it is expected that the couple contact the pastor before making other arrangements for the wedding. This initial contact should be at least one year prior to the desired date of marriage.

Sacrament of Baptism: Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays at Our Lady of Grace at 1:00 p.m., and at Most Precious Blood immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass, which parents and Godparents are expected to attend. You must be a registered member of Our Lady of Peace Parish. Godparents must be baptized Catholics who are practicing their faith. Expectant parents are required to receive instruction before the baptism of their child. If you are expecting a child in the next six months, please contact the parish office to register for this instruction.

Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor: It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis.

To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.

#### Dear family in Jesus Christ:

Psalm 89 gives us some keys that help us as a warning, to always be



aware that our life is transitory in this world, that is, passing through. That is why he used the term: 1) Our life is brief as a dream. 2) You return man to dust. Therefore, the word also opens our conscience and with humility we say to God: 1) fill us with your love in the morning and our life will be joyful. 2) Consciously we ask Him to teach us to see what life is, so that we may be wise

Because if not, it will happen to us like the example of today's Gospel, which Jesus proposes to apply to our personal life: This poor man did not transcend. Why? 1) God himself tells him, this very night you are going to die. And note that God's mouth, rarely, we find the term die, it is always sleep. 2) This man did not think of anyone to whom he was going to leave things; it was always in Me:

My harvest, My barns, My soul, My life, My security. Everything was Me. Let's apply it to reality. There are people, parents or friends who work hard to leave inheritances. But they do not prepare the heirs, who are the generational relay. Ask yourself to whom are you going to give your assets? You know to whom, but there is something bigger, do not leave only goods, leave also "LEGACY".

What are the legacies? Teach them to work, training, education, raise their awareness, make them as much as possible to be good Christians and honest citizens. Because remember that God has already put riches in your life, and you have to transform them into legacies. As are the talents. Those talents teach them, transmit them, because if not people will look at you as an artist or athlete etc... They will watch you perform; they will applaud you; they will admire you, and they will praise you. But what excites them?

I conclude by telling you: Get rich of what is worth before God, not of what is worth before the world, with the man who reflects a situation, who live in the same family, who love each other only for the inheritances, and some more seen that they keep everything. Do not give importance at all to temporary things that do not give you happiness. How many people even have shares in the stock market, and how they suffer before the falls that these suffer and many times, they even get sick. God does not make sick but heals. Choose and encourage, point out the gifts of God.


