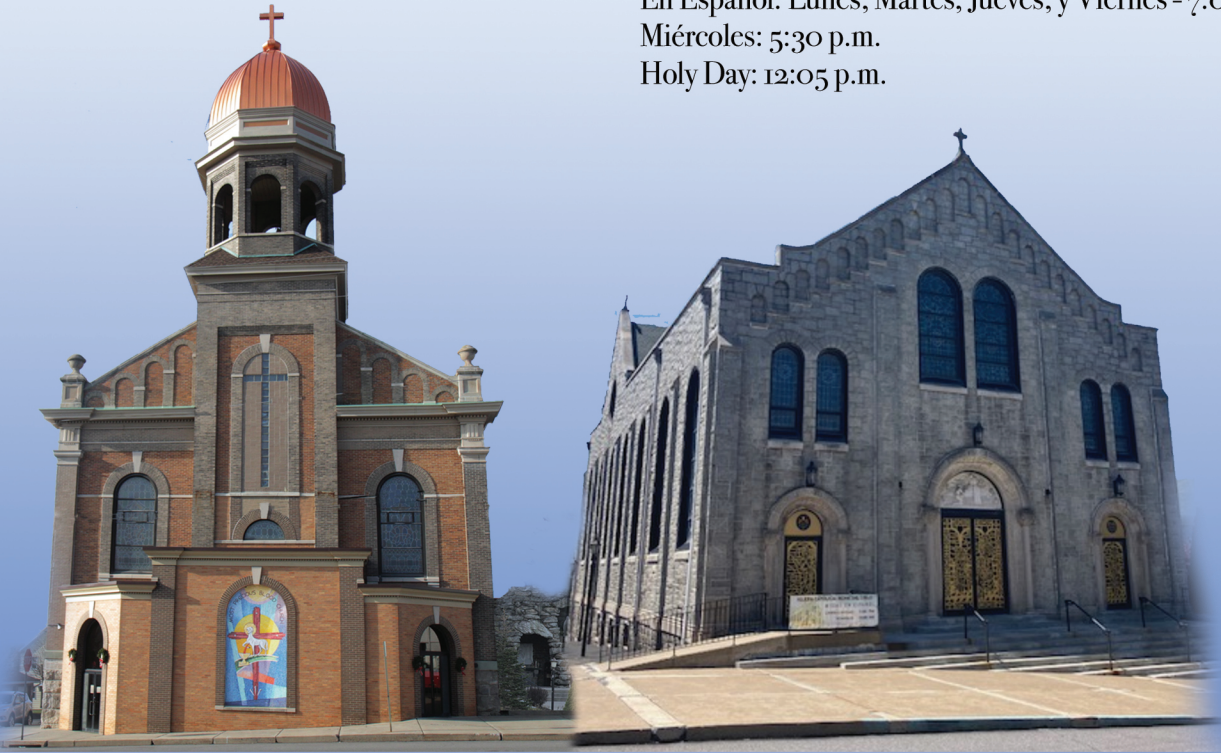

Sacrament of Matrimony: In order to properly prepare for marriage, it is expected that the couple contact the pastor before making other arrangements for the wedding. This initial contact should be at least one year prior to the desired date of marriage.

Sacrament of Baptism: Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays at Our Lady of Grace at 1:00 p.m., and at Most Precious Blood immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass, which parents and Godparents are expected to attend. You must be a registered member of Our Lady of Peace Parish. Godparents must be baptized Catholics who are practicing their faith. Expectant parents are required to receive instruction before the baptism of their child. If you are expecting a child in the next six months, please contact the parish office to register for this instruction.

Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor: It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis.

To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.

Last weekend, the Hazleton deanery was privileged to experience a most exhilarating spiritual experiences as our parish hosted the Saint Carlo Acutis Eucharistic Miracle Exhibition. The event was truly a work of Our Lord under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit! I am truly grateful for the experience of Saint Carlo's influence in introducing Jesus and His Mother, Mary, to us in a new and exciting way. Attendance at the exhibit and the liturgical celebrations was more than anyone really expected. Mr. Jeff Daily, the curator of the exhibit at the Saint Carlo Acutis Shrine in Malvern, PA, that ours was one of the most attended in his experience of traveling with the exhibit to other parishes in a variety of dioceses and archdioceses in the northeast. Mr. Daily said that we passed out approximately 700 Saint Carlo prayer cards to those who made the pilgrimage. That's absolutely remarkable! I was particularly moved by a few discoveries and encounters that I'd like to share. The first is the discovery that the church of San Mauro La Bruca is a site of a Eucharistic Miracle that occurred in the town of San Mauro La Bruca, Italy in 1969. As many of you know, Saint Mauro is the patron saint we honor at Our Lady of Grace church. Seeing the write up and pictures Saint Carlo preserved on one of the placards came as a surprise to me and I felt so humbled by the realization. Another moving moment for me was to view the video documentary about Saint Carlo. I had never heard and seen a saint's mother, Antonia, and his friends and associates speak of someone so uniquely in communion with our Lord and Mary. I couldn't help but weep each time I stopped to watch the video. I even recognized a professor I had during my canon law studies offer a commentary on Saint Carlo. Quite the surprise! And perhaps the most moving moments of the experience was the opportunity to bless individuals with the relic of Saint Carlo Acutis. We all experience the challenges life brings to us. I found the opportunity to serve folks in search of some peace by invoking Saint Carlo's intercession for them.

I want to thank all who came out from the parish and the deanery to help put this all together and help make it the success that it was. The people from our parish and others really made it all come together. Thank you very much. Finally, Saint Carlo had an immense love for the poor. Through his inspiration I hope we can support Rectory, Set, Cook, an event meant to raise money for Catholic Social Services of the Diocese of Scranton. Use the QR Code to register and donate. Cuarto Domingo de Cuaresma – Domingo "Laetare"
La liturgia de este cuarto domingo de Cuaresma introduce un tono de esperanza en medio del camino penitencial. Tradicionalmente es llamado Domingo Laetare, el domingo de la alegría, porque Dios no nos llama a la conversión para condenarnos, sino para devolvernos la luz. La primera lectura presenta un criterio profundamente divino para discernir la vida. Cuando Samuel busca al nuevo rey entre los hijos de Jesé, humanamente todo parecía indicar que el elegido sería el mayor, el fuerte, el que tenía apariencia de liderazgo. Pero Dios corrige la mirada del profeta: "El hombre mira las apariencias, pero el Señor mira el corazón" (1 Sam 16,7). Según explican los exegetas, aquí se revela una pedagogía espiritual constante en la Biblia: Dios no elige según el prestigio, el poder o la imagen exterior, sino según la verdad interior del corazón. David, el menor y aparentemente insignificante, es ungido porque su interior está abierto a Dios. San Pablo, en la carta a los Efesios, conecta esta elección divina con la vida cristiana: "Antes eran tinieblas, ahora son luz en el Señor" (Ef 5,8). Para el apóstol, la conversión no es solo un cambio moral, sino una transformación de identidad. El cristiano pasa de la oscuridad a la luz. Vivir en la luz significa dejar que la verdad de Dios ilumine nuestras decisiones, nuestras relaciones y nuestras prioridades. Por eso Pablo exhorta: "Despierta tú que duermes, levántate de entre los muertos y Cristo será tu luz" (Ef 5,14). Es un llamado directo a salir de la ceguera espiritual. El Evangelio de San Juan desarrolla esta verdad mediante el signo del ciego de nacimiento. Jesús no solo devuelve la vista física a aquel hombre; revela algo mucho más profundo. Mientras el ciego comienza a ver progresivamente quién es Jesús primero un hombre, luego un profeta, finalmente el Señor, los fariseos, que físicamente ven, se hunden cada vez más en la ceguera espiritual. Como señalan muchos comentaristas bíblicos, Juan presenta aquí una paradoja poderosa: el verdadero problema no es no ver, sino creer que ya se ve. Este evangelio confronta directamente nuestro tiempo. También hoy existe una ceguera que no se reconoce a sí misma: la autosuficiencia, el orgullo espiritual, la convicción de que no necesitamos que Dios ilumine nuestra vida. Cuando el corazón se cierra a la verdad, incluso la evidencia de la gracia puede ser rechazada. La Cuaresma es precisamente el tiempo en que Cristo quiere tocar nuestros ojos. Él sigue pasando por nuestra vida para preguntarnos, como al ciego curado: "¿Crees en el Hijo del Hombre?". La verdadera conversión comienza cuando reconocemos nuestra necesidad de luz y dejamos que Cristo ilumine nuestras oscuridades. Pidamos al Señor en este tiempo cuaresmal que sane nuestra mirada interior, para que podamos ver la vida, a los demás y a nosotros mismos con la luz de Dios.
