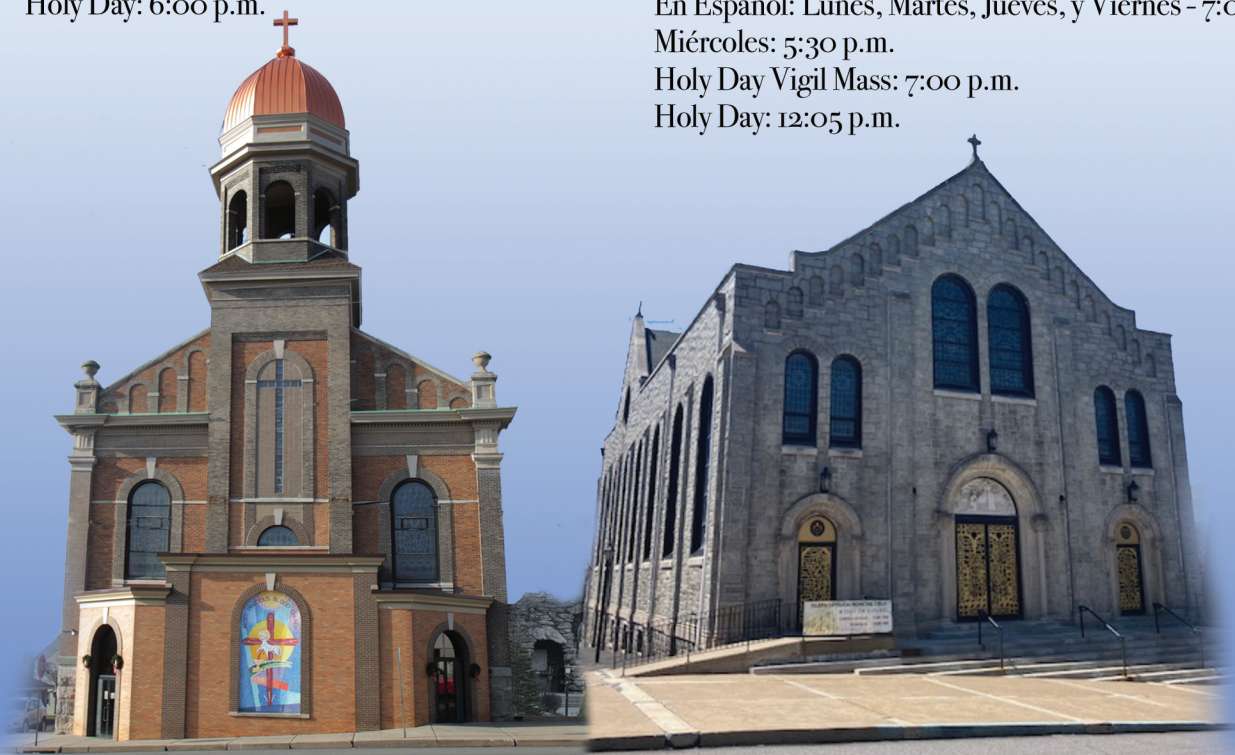

Sacrament of Matrimony: In order to properly prepare for marriage, it is expected that the couple contact the pastor before making other arrangements for the wedding. This initial contact should be at least one year prior to the desired date of marriage.

Sacrament of Baptism: Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays at Our Lady of Grace at 1:00 p.m., and at Most Precious Blood immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass, which parents and Godparents are expected to attend. You must be a registered member of Our Lady of Peace Parish. Godparents must be baptized Catholics who are practicing their faith. Expectant parents are required to receive instruction before the baptism of their child. If you are expecting a child in the next six months, please contact the parish office to register for this instruction.

Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor: It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis.

To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.

PASTOR'S REFLEXIÓN CORNER DEL PASTOR

Querida familia de Nuestra Señora de La Paz, al encontrarnos en este Domingo Décimo séptimo del tiempo ordinario, se nos regala la oración, como un medio de encontrarnos con Jesús, siempre y cuando de verdad nosotros lo deseemos.

Debemos de partir de tener un Espíritu humilde, como lo hacen los discípulos, que le dicen al Señor Jesús; enséñanos a Orar. Pero no avancemos sin hacernos una pregunta clave. ¿Qué les motivó o movió su interés de hacerle esta solicitud? Porque descubrieron que no era suficiente con solo mirarlo orar.

En primer lugar, dice una rica expresión: que las palabras convencen, pero los ejemplos arrastran. Ese es uno de los motivos que favorecen a los apóstoles, que miran en el Señor Jesucristo que no hay contradicción; entre su orar y su actuar. Lo cual les provoca confianza, como miramos en la oración dialogada de nuestro padre Abraham.

Los apóstoles ven en el Señor, que, al regresar de orar, hay alegría, paz, felicidad y siempre esa actitud de seguir sin parar en su misión salvífica. Lo contrario en muchos cristianos de HOY QUE DEJAN MUCHO QUE DESEAR. Aunque los veamos practicando vida sacramental, ejerciendo ministerios dentro de las comunidades parroquiales, pues en sus rostros, palabras y hechos a nadie arrastran, mejor confunden o crean dudas y hasta temores. Ellos hablan con su boca de que han cambiado, pero con nuestros ojos y oídos vemos y oímos lo contrario.

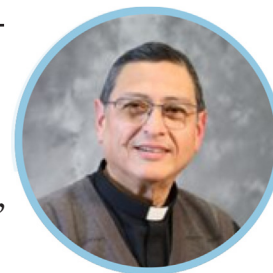
En mi misma experiencia lo veo, si el padre de familia orará, el niño de la catequesis llegaría por lo menos sabiendo el Padre Nuestro y el Dios te Salve María.

El señor Jesús nos enseña: 1) Orar es aprender amar y dejarse amar. 2) Orar es adorar a Dios. Porque adorar es ponerle por encima de todas las cosas. 3) Orar es confiar. Por eso en la parábola de hoy, el que presta el pan confío que su conocido, aunque sea de mal humor lo concederá, cuanto más Dios. 4) Orar es nunca estar solo. Por eso la oración del padre nuestro es en plural y no en singular. Por eso decimos en la Misa: El Señor reciba de tus manos, este sacrificio para nuestro bien, y el de toda su Santa Iglesia. 5) Orar es pedir el Espíritu Santo. Si alguien de verdad quiere, aprender a orar, el maestro principal es El Espíritu Santo.

REV. RAFAEL O'FARRIL. ASSISTANT PASTOR/ OUR LADY OF PEACE PARISH



Dear family of Our Lady of Peace, as we meet on this Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, we are given the gift of prayer as a means of meeting Jesus, if and when we truly desire it.

We must start with a humble spirit, as the disciples do, who say to the Lord Jesus: teach us to pray. But let us not move forward without asking ourselves a key question: What motivated them or moved their interest in making this request?

Because they discovered that it was not enough to just watch him pray. In the first place, he says a rich expression: that words convince, but examples drag. This is one of the reasons that favor the apostles, who see in the Lord Jesus Christ that there is no contradiction between their prayer and their actions. This gives them confidence, as we see in the prayer in dialogue of our father Abraham.

The apostles see in the Lord, that when they return from praying, there is joy, peace, happiness and always that attitude of continuing without stopping in their salvific mission. The opposite is true of many Christians today who leave much to be desired. Although we see them practicing sacramental life, exercising ministries within the parish communities, because in their faces, words and deeds they do not drag anyone, but rather confuse or create doubts and even fears. They speak with their mouths that they have changed, but with our eyes and ears we see and hear the opposite.

In my own experience, if the parent would pray, the child in catechesis would arrive at least knowing the Our Father and Hail Mary.

The Lord Jesus teaches us: 1) To pray is to learn to love and to let oneself be loved. 2) To pray is to adore God. Because to adore is to put Him above all things. 3) To pray is to trust. That is why in today's parable, the one who lends the bread trusts that his acquaintance, even if he is in a bad mood, will grant it, how much more God. 4) To pray is never to be alone. That is why the prayer of the Our Father is in the plural and not in the singular. That is why we say at Mass: May the Lord receive from your hands, this sacrifice for our good, and that of all his Holy Church. 5) To pray is to ask for the Holy Spirit. If someone really wants to learn to pray, the main teacher is the Holy Spirit.
