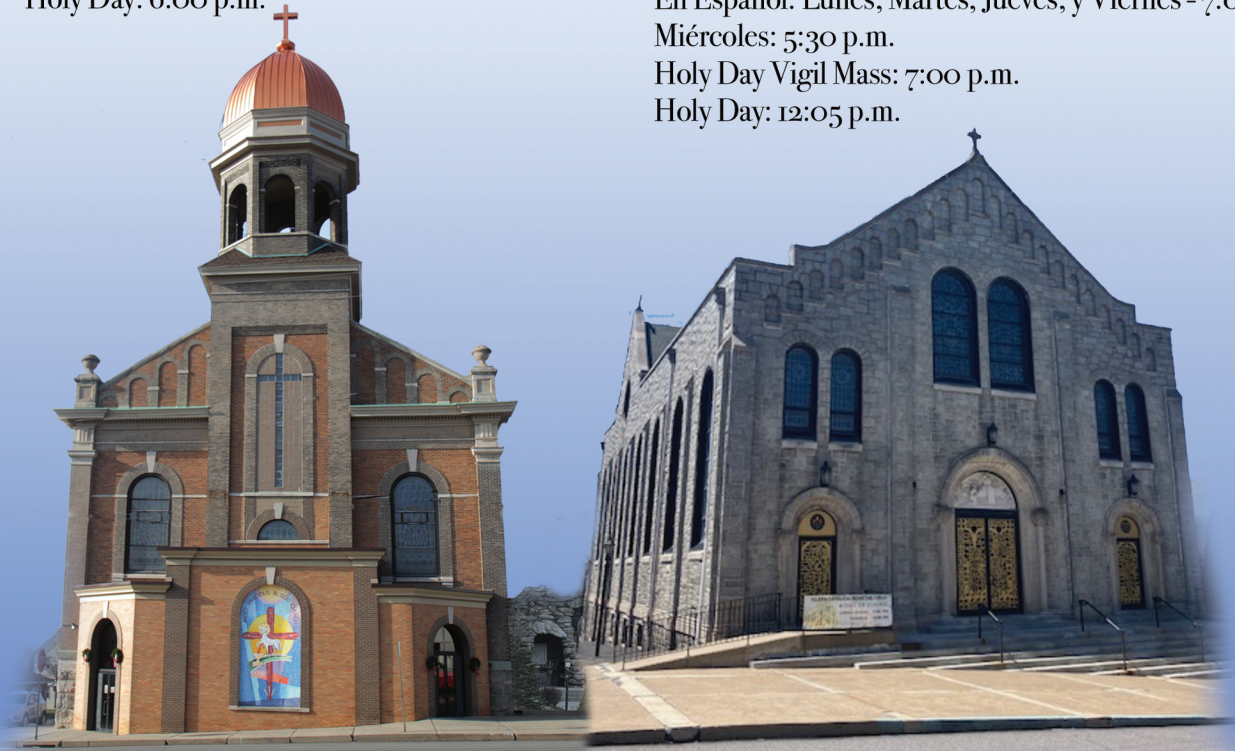

**Sacrament of Matrimony:** In order to properly prepare for marriage, it is expected that the couple contact the pastor before making other arrangements for the wedding. This initial contact should be at least one year prior to the desired date of marriage.

**Sacrament of Baptism:** Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays at Our Lady of Grace at 1:00 p.m., and at Most Precious Blood immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass, which parents and Godparents are expected to attend. You must be a registered member of Our Lady of Peace Parish. Godparents must be baptized Catholics who are practicing their faith. Expectant parents are required to receive instruction before the baptism of their child. If you are expecting a child in the next six months, please contact the parish office to register for this instruction.

**Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor:** It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at [www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis](http://www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis).

To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.

## PASTOR'S REFLEXIÓN CORNER DEL PASTOR FUEGO Y DIVISIÓN

El fuego del Espíritu Santo, que Cristo ha traído a nuestra vida, por medio del Bautismo, es el que provoca División. Porque cuando el hombre, de verdad se pone a vivir, esa fuerza y vida Divina, se vuelve y apasionado y de alma, vida, cuerpo y corazón se compromete, en vivir el reino de Dios y de transmitirlo, con una vida ejemplar y con sus palabras.

Entonces tomar esa vida, nos lleva, a no vivir en nuestra misma vida interior en Paz, sino en guerra o por lo menos en constante división. Porque la naturaleza nos inclina por instinto al mundo, a que abracemos la vida mundana y no tomar la vida sana y perfecta de Dios. Pero el Espíritu Santo, pone en alerta nuestra reflexión y conciencia, que no nos dejemos engañar. Es por eso por lo que debes de ser ardiente de FE, para que no te apagues, ante las dificultades o tempestades, como lo advirtió el Señor Jesús, en la parábola de la casa construida sobre arena, que el viento, o las corrientes la arrancaron y acabaron con ellas. A veces no son tan fuertes las dificultades, basta con encontrarse con personas, inconscientes, inconformes, incoherente, o agresivos impulsivos y ya te sientes abatido y permites que te cambien, en tus sueños, propósitos y actos.

Solo el Espíritu Santo, nos hace mantenernos en auténtica paz, que no es ausencia de conflicto, sino que no vivo para los conflictos, sino para Cristo, que consiste en vivir de acuerdo con su voluntad y no la de tantas voces, que te deterioran emocionalmente y nunca estás bien con ellos. ¿Quiénes son esas voces?

El Evangelio lo define así: donde una familia de cinco, estarán tres contra dos, dos contra tres. El padre contra el hijo etc. Por eso SAN Pablo dirá en Gálatas 5,16-26: vivan según el Espíritu Santo y no busquen satisfacer, sus propios malos deseos .... Concluyó invitándote que leas y reflexiones, esta cita completa. Basta a como dice el versículo 26, No seamos orgullosos, ni sembremos rivalidades y envidias entre nosotros.

## REV. RAFAEL O'FARRIL. ASSISTANT PASTOR/ OUR LADY OF PEACE PARISH FIRE AND DIVISION



The fire of the Holy Spirit, which Christ has brought into our lives through Baptism, is what causes division. Because when man truly begins to live, that divine strength and life becomes passionate, and with soul, life, body, and heart, he commits himself to living the kingdom of God and transmitting it through an exemplary life and his words.

Taking that life leads us to not live in peace within ourselves, but rather in conflict or at least in constant division. Because nature instinctively inclines us toward the world, to embrace worldly life and not take the healthy and perfect life of God. But the Holy Spirit alerts our reflection and conscience, so that we are not deceived. To achieve this, as we were told last Sunday, we must be vigilant, because we do not know at what hour the evil one will want to penetrate.

That is why it is important that we cannot have a WARM life, for the Lord Jesus Christ has told us, "I wish you were cold or preferably hot, but never warm." Because warm are those who have stagnated, who settle, who become conformists, who do not grow and therefore do not bear fruit in any sense, and even more so, who sometimes do so consciously.

That is why you must be fervent in your FAITH, so that you do not lose heart in the face of difficulties or storms, as the Lord Jesus warned in the parable of the house built on sand, which the wind or currents tore down and destroyed. Sometimes the difficulties are not so great; it is enough to encounter people who are unconscious, dissatisfied, incoherent, or impulsively aggressive, and you already feel defeated and allow them to change your dreams, purposes, and actions.

Only the Holy Spirit keeps us in true peace, which is not the absence of conflict, but rather not living for conflict, but for Christ, which consists of living according to His will and not that of so many voices that emotionally deteriorate you and with which you are never at peace. Who are these voices?

The Gospel defines it this way: where there is a family of five, there will be three against two, two against three. The father against the son, etc. That is why St. Paul says in Galatians 5:16-26: live according to the Holy Spirit and do not seek to satisfy your own evil desires.... He concluded by inviting you to read and reflect on this entire passage. Suffice it to say, as verse 26 says, let us not be proud, nor show rivalry and envy among ourselves.

Praise be to Jesus Christ the Lord.

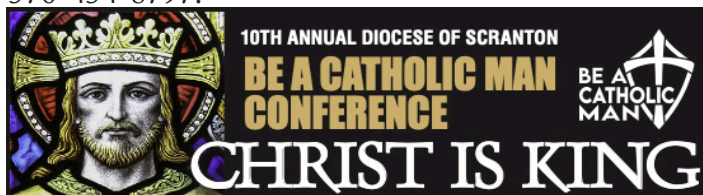
