

**CCD Classes:** are held every Sunday morning from 8:45 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. at Most Precious Blood.

**Sacrament of Matrimony:** In order to properly prepare for marriage, it is expected that the couple contact the pastor before making other arrangements for the wedding. This initial contact should be at least one year prior to the desired date of marriage.

**Sacrament of Baptism:** Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays at Our Lady of Grace at 1:00 p.m., and at Most Precious Blood immediately following the 10:30 a.m. Mass, which parents and Godparents are expected to attend. You must be a registered member of Our Lady of Peace Parish. Godparents must be baptized Catholics who are practicing their faith. Expectant parents are required to receive instruction before the baptism of their child. If you are expecting a child in the next six months, please contact the parish office to register for this instruction.

**Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor:** It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at [www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis](http://www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis).

To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.

Our Lady of Peace Parish continues the rich tradition of all the Catholic communities which laid a foundation of faith in the city of Hazleton. As today's Gospel reminds us, we testify to Jesus, who takes away the sins of the world. This is the Good News entrusted to the Church, guided by the Holy Spirit.

How is Our Lady of Peace Parish best able to share the Gospel message? What resources do we need to effectively carry out Christ's commission to "make disciples of all nations" (Matthew 28:19)? Over the next several months, the pastoral and finance councils will consider these questions and share information with the parish to inform everyone about the opportunities and challenges. As part of the discussion, the future of Our Lady of Grace Church must be determined. Bishop Bambera has asked for a recommendation from the parish no later than July 1, 2026.

Together, we will chart the path forward, taking into consideration the changing dynamics of the local community, along with the financial constraints and facility needs of the parish. While we adjust to change of this nature, we must remember that the Mission of God is constant, calling us to go outside ourselves to serve the world in need of mercy, love and salvation.

**La parroquia Nuestra Señora de la Paz** continúa la rica tradición de todas las comunidades católicas que sentaron las bases de la fe en la ciudad de Hazleton. Como nos recuerda el Evangelio de hoy, damos testimonio de Jesús, que quita los pecados del mundo. Esta es la Buena Nueva confiada a la Iglesia, guiada por el Espíritu Santo.

¿Cómo puede la parroquia Nuestra Señora de la Paz compartir mejor el mensaje del Evangelio? ¿Qué recursos necesitamos para llevar a cabo eficazmente la misión de Cristo de «hacer discípulos a todas las naciones» (Mateo 28, 19)? Durante los próximos meses, los consejos pastoral y financiero considerarán estas cuestiones y compartirán la información con la parroquia para informar a todos sobre las oportunidades y los retos. Como parte del debate, se debe determinar el futuro de la iglesia Nuestra Señora de la Gracia. El obispo Bambera ha solicitado una recomendación de la parroquia a más tardar el 1 de julio de 2026.

Juntos, trazaremos el camino a seguir, teniendo en cuenta la dinámica cambiante de la comunidad local, junto con las limitaciones financieras y las necesidades de instalaciones de la parroquia. Mientras nos adaptamos a un cambio de esta naturaleza, debemos recordar que la misión de Dios es constante y nos llama a salir de nosotros mismos para servir al mundo que necesita misericordia, amor y salvación.

**EL TIEMPO ORDINARIO**

Un camino cotidiano para vivir el Evangelio  
Con la celebración del Bautismo del Señor, la Iglesia inicia el Tiempo Ordinario, una etapa fundamental del año litúrgico que, lejos de ser un tiempo "sin importancia", es el espacio donde la fe se encarna en la vida diaria.

Se llama "ordinario" no porque sea rutinario o pobre en contenido, sino porque está ordenado: nos introduce en el ritmo constante y paciente del seguimiento de Jesucristo. Después de contemplar los grandes misterios de la Navidad, la Pascua y Pentecostés, la Iglesia nos invita ahora a caminar con Jesús día a día, escuchando su Palabra, aprendiendo de sus gestos, y dejándonos transformar por su manera de amar.

¿Qué significa el Tiempo Ordinario?

El Tiempo Ordinario nos presenta a Jesús en su vida pública: enseñando, sanando, llamando discípulos, confrontando corazones y revelando el rostro misericordioso del Padre. Es el tiempo del discípulo que aprende, del creyente que madura en la fe y descubre que la santidad se vive en lo cotidiano: en la familia, en el trabajo, en la comunidad, en las decisiones sencillas de cada día.

La Palabra de Dios, proclamada domingo tras domingo, no busca sólo ser escuchada, sino acogida, meditada y vivida. En este tiempo, el Evangelio se convierte en una escuela permanente donde Cristo nos forma por dentro, corrige nuestras actitudes y nos impulsa a una fe coherente y comprometida.

¿Qué alcance desea tener la Iglesia en este tiempo? A través del Tiempo Ordinario, la Iglesia desea que la Palabra de Dios:

- Ilumina la vida real de los fieles, allí donde se viven alegrías, luchas, heridas y esperanzas.
- Forme conciencias maduras, capaces de discernir y actuar según el Evangelio.
- Conduzca a una fe encarnada, que no se quede solo en celebraciones, sino que se traduzca en caridad, justicia, servicio y misericordia.
- Fortalezca la comunidad, ayudándonos a caminar juntos como pueblo de Dios, sostenidos por la Eucaristía y la escucha fiel de la Palabra.
- El color verde que caracteriza este tiempo litúrgico simboliza la esperanza y el crecimiento. Es el crecimiento lento pero firme de la fe, como una semilla que germina en el corazón cuando se la cuida con perseverancia.
- Un tiempo para dejarnos formar

El Tiempo Ordinario nos recuerda que Dios actúa de manera constante, silenciosa y fiel. No siempre en lo extraordinario, sino en lo pequeño, en lo repetido, en lo diario. Quien se abre a este tiempo descubre que cada domingo es una nueva oportunidad para crecer, convertirse y renovar el compromiso bautismal.

Que este Tiempo Ordinario sea para todos nosotros un camino de escucha profunda, de conversión sincera y de vida cristiana coherente, para que la Palabra de Dios dé fruto abundante en nuestra comunidad.


