

Drivers (and all who may read this), I want you to...



When you drive OTR, especially out west, you are always looking as far as you can see and wondering what's over the horizon or what's over the next hill. Well, I have no doubts that God wants you to dream big and God wants to give you the desires of your heart. When I say dream big, I'm not just talking about wishing for something, but instead praying boldly and trusting God to expand your life beyond anything you have ever imagined. I want you to step boldly into God's territory and dream beyond the horizons that you can see.

Let me introduce you to someone in the Bible, a man named Jabez. Jabez literally means "pain" or "sorrow." Imagine carrying that around all of your life! And yet, his story is one of courage, prayer, and breakthrough. Let's read the prayer of Jabez (1 Chronicles 4:10) together — "And Jabez called on the name of the God of Israel, saying, oh that thou wouldest bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast, and that thine hand might be with me, and that thou wouldest keep me from evil, that it may not grieve me! And God granted him that which he requested." Jabez got what he asked for! Through all of the pain and disappoints in his life, he still had the courage to pray boldly, knowing that God hears and wants to answer our prayers. He asked God to bless him and to enlarge or increase his territory, and for His hand to be

with him and keep him from harm. Jabez was saying, God I want everything you have for me!

Driver, have you ever felt like your past or your circumstances were holding you back? Maybe they labeled you? Maybe life has just hurt you? I want you to know that, like Jabez, your past does not define you. Let go of labels and past pains that someone else may have put on you. Pray and ask God specifically for His blessing and His power in areas where you need Him. Step into that new territory by faith. Don't just dream; you've got to move. Trust God as you take that next step. Just because people have put labels on you or told you that you could not do so and so, doesn't mean anything if God is in it.

It's like the story of Michael Jordan, who was cut from the varsity team at his high school. His coach said he wasn't good enough, but Michael didn't let that stop him. He just kept working harder until he became one of the greatest ballplayers the NBA has ever had. What if he had listened to that coach that said he wasn't "good enough?" We probably wouldn't even know his name.

God said in Jeremiah 29:11, "For I know the thoughts that I think towards you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end." And it's a good one, Driver. Jeremiah 29:12 says he expects you to pray and call on Him and then He will listen to you!

Ephesians 3:20 says that God is "able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us." Drivers, I pray that you will allow the Holy Spirit to work in you, and dream big, and pray big God-sized prayers for your life and for the lives of your families. What is a God-sized prayer? That is a prayer that if God doesn't answer it there is no other way for it to happen!

Do not let your past pain or someone else define who you are. If you have given your life to Christ, you are a child of the King and I encourage you to live like it! Believe God and His word for your life. Pray like Jabez and let God grant your request. Dream big!

I praise God for that lit cross on the side of the Chapel that night. He was on the doorstep of eternity in

hell without Jesus—but God intervened. I will always believe in and support the need to have Chapels, manned as much as possible, permanently placed in truck stops.


We want to thank each of you for your giving in 2025. Through <u>your</u> generosity, God has allowed you to minister




