The Truth Will Set You Free

We at **Too Far Out Farm, LLC** build on **Truth**, walk in **Faith** & serve with **Obedience**. We do this at **TFO Farm** through horse play! My message here touches on my musings about **TRUTH**.

I think of myself as a truth-seeker, meaning that, I place an emphasis on discovering and living out what is true. The truth is not always very popular, but I prefer it, none-the-less. Here's why...



*...so you can be **certain** of the truth of everything you were taught. ~Luke 1:4 (NLT)*

In recovery circles, we talk about coming out of denial. That means facing the truth, even when it's unpleasant, uncomfortable, or even painful to acknowledge. The choice to avoid and/or ignore particular realities is a way to escape discomfort and pain. That is denial. When I was still in active addiction, I drank alcohol to escape my unpleasant reality, b u t ...

Denial landed me in a world of **confusion**, **uncertainty**, and **chaos** in my relationships, my job and pretty much every other aspect of my life. Living outside of the truth, in other words, outside of reality is, by definition, just plain **insanity**. That's not living at all! It was like existing alone in a dark vacuum. Denial caused me to do the same thing over and over again, expecting a different result. That "merry-go-round" was relentlessly frustrating, but I did not know how to get off that tedious and unfruitful ride!

Being raised in the church, I innately knew that God tells the truth, but I couldn't, in my own strength, understand, believe, or apply the spiritual principles that I read in the Bible. Christians were telling me that God loves me, but **I could not feel** it! The biggest lie I believed was that I was not loved, wanted or useful to anyone, let alone by a God whom I could not see. I felt hopelessly flawed. I needed a savior.

Deeply wounded by sin - our own and that of others - is not our death sentence. At **TFO Farm** Jesus can and does use the horses to help us see and accept ourselves, others (*and Him!*) in light of reality. Regular exposure to the kind of pure honesty that horses possess can be uplifting and even transformational.
