- Exhibits must be grown by exhibitor
- Exhibits to place on white plates or white cardboard plates, unless otherwise instructed
- At least one egg will be broken Eggs to be presented in ½ Dozen egg carton
- Bunches or collections of herbs to be displayed in clear containers of water that is an appropriate size for the exhibit & named
- All exhibits MUST have an entry ticket attached otherwise the exhibits will be classed out
- All care taken but no responsibility accepted by PA&H Association
- Prize money to be collected from Secretary's Office during the show.
