- All hand-knitted items must be entirely hand knitted.

6. Best hand knitted article, any medium
7. Infant's hand-knitted set (coat, bonnet & bootees)
8. Child's hand-knitted pullover
9. One dress hanger
10. Best article wool or acrylic crochet
11. Any machine or handmade article made by person over 60yrs
12. Best article cotton or acrylic crocheted by person over 60yrs
13. Best knitted or crocheted article made by a person over 80yrs (trophy donated by Allison Allen)
14. Novelty article suitable for Christmas gift
15. Crocheted knee rug (no bigger than 50"x 65")
16. Child's hand-knitted or crocheted cardigan or pullover
17. Cuddle toy, any material
18. Any article of needlework not mentioned in section S.
19. Attractive and practical article made from material scraps
20. Beanie, knitted or crocheted
21. Baby pram cover crochet (30"x 36")
22. Shopping bag – replacing plastic shopping bag – any medium
