Hot Dog Etignette: Yes, it's a Thing...

There IS hot dog etiquette. *The National Hot Dog and Sausage Council* says so! Here are some highlights.

- Always put condiments on the hot dog, not. the. bun!
- **△** Condiments should be applied in this order: wet condiments like mustard and chili THEN chunky condiments like relish, onions and sauerkraut THEN shredded cheese THEN spices, like celery salt or pepper.
- Serve plain, sesame seed or poppy seed buns with hot dogs. Do not serve sun-dried tomato buns or basil buns. That's gauche.
- Lise a paper napkin to wipe your mouth, not cloth! Use paper plates. Even everyday dishes are acceptable. But china is a no no. And do not put fresh herbs on the same plate as your hot dogs in an effort to dress them up.
- **Eat hot dogs on buns with your hands. Utensils SHOULD NOT TOUCH hot dogs on buns.**
- ♦ After the age of one, do not use ketchup on your hot dog. You must graduate to mustard, relish, onions, cheese and chili.
- Finish a hot dog in five bites, seven bites for a foot-long wiener. Condiments remaining on the fingers after eating a hot dog should be licked away, never washed.
- Eat all of it. Don't leave bits of buns behind. (As if we need to be told that!)




SaveSmart Insurance Tip




Taking Care of What's Overhead

A SPECIAL SIGN COMES HOME



In the 1960s, this metal sign was proudly affixed to the vehicle of Lee Ryan, original owner of the Ryan Agencies. It was a great advertising tool for quite some time.
