Reflection Points

- Recall events when the hand of Jesus pulled you out of danger.
- What are the hindrances for us to recognize the Lord?

We are reminded of a previous story in Chapter 8 of Matthew's Gospel, when Jesus calms the seas. This time, however, Jesus does not calm the seas, and the disciples do not express fear until they see Jesus walking toward them on the water. In this story it is not the storm that is feared but the sight of Jesus before them, whom they mistake for a ghost. Clues like these suggest that this story is about the disciples' growing understanding of the identity of Jesus. In continuity with last week's Gospel about the feeding of the multitude, today's Gospel is also about what the disciples' faith in Jesus will enable them to do. In last week's Gospel, when the disciples see the crowds, they ask Jesus to send the crowds away. Jesus turns the situation around, telling the disciples to feed the crowd with the provisions that they have. Both of these Gospels tell us much about ministry.

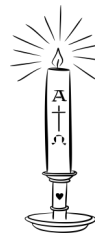

Stewards of the Gospel

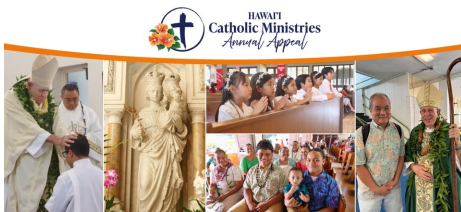
"He said, 'Come.' Peter got out of the boat and began to walk on the water toward Jesus." - MATTHEW 14:29

Brief History-Key Points

Chapter Four: Sisters, Saints, and Sacrifice (1850-1880s)

- The loss of the Marie Joseph delayed the arrival of Sacred Hearts Sisters for sixteen years.
- New religious orders expanded Catholic education and service throughout Hawaii.
- The Marinist Brothers opened St. Louis School, which later contributed to the Development of Chaminade University.
- Mother Marianne Cope and the Franciscan Sisters answered King Kalakaua's plea to serve those with Hansen's disease.
- St. Damien and Saint Marianne became enduring witnesses of sacrificial service in Hawaii.

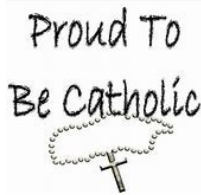

we remember His words:

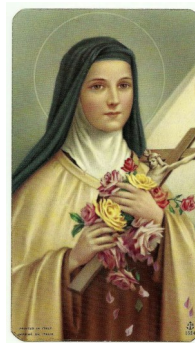
“Don’t be afraid. Take courage. I am
