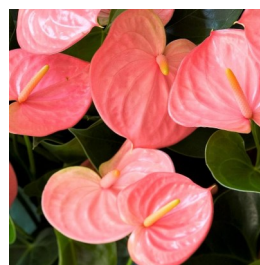

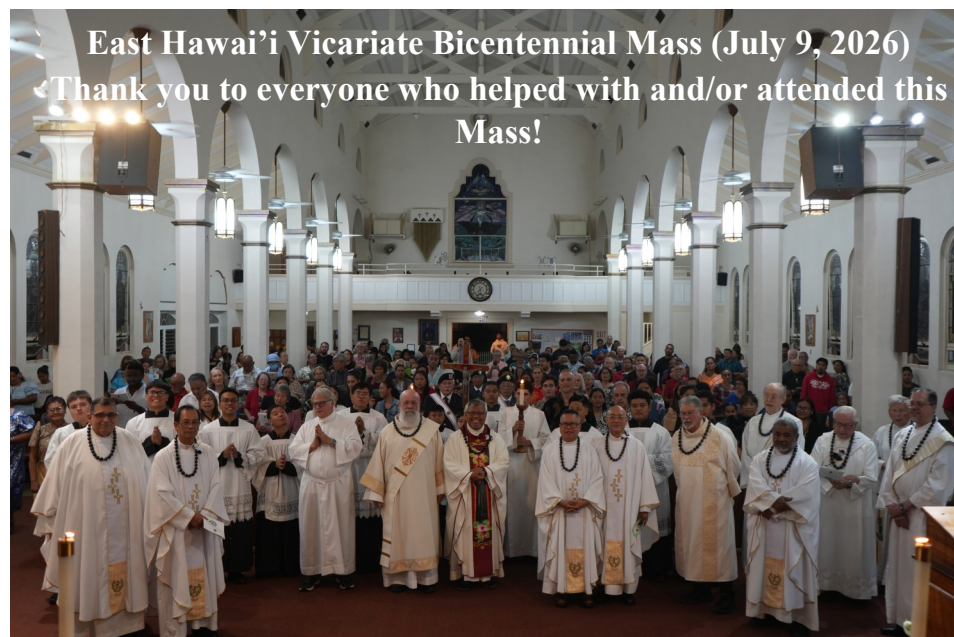

200 Years of Catholicism in Hawaii 1827-2027 "Mission of Aloha" Brief History-Key Points

Perseverance Through Persecution (1831-1839)

- The early missionaries were not well received by those in power and Catholic practice was restricted.
- Father Bachelot and Father Short were expelled in 1831, but the SS.CC. Brothers and Hawaiian Lay catechists preserved the faith community.
- The Catholic community endured nearly a decade without priests, sacraments, or formal support.
- The 1839 Edict of Toleration restored Catholic Freedom of worship in Hawaii.

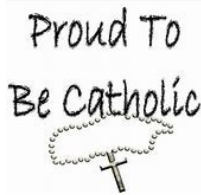
