

## Stewards of the Gospel

"...because I came down from heaven not to do my own will but the will of the one who sent me....'" JOHN 6:38

**Plenary Indulgences During All Souls** Week (Nov. 2 - 8)

#### On November 2nd (All Souls' Day) or the week of November 1-8

**Pious visit:** Visit a church or cemetery and pray for the deceased.

Specific prayers: At a church, say one "Our Father" and the "Apostles' Creed." At a cemetery, mental or vocal prayers for the dead are sufficient.

#### To gain the indulgence, you must also meet these three prerequisites:

Confession: Make a valid sacramental confession within about 20 days before or after the act.

Communion: Receive Holy Communion within about 20 days before or after the act.

Prayer for the Pope: Pray for the intentions of the Holy Father (at least one "Our Father" and one "Hail Mary" are suggested).

#### **Essential disposition**

**Detachment from sin:** Be completely and wholeheartedly detached from all sin, including venial sin; otherwise, only a partial indulgence is gained.

One indulgence per day: A person can only gain one plenary indulgence per day.

Application to the souls in Purgatory: These specific indulgences are applicable *only* to the souls in Purgatory and cannot be applied to oneself.


