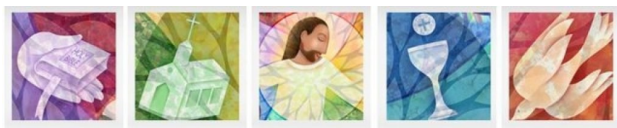

## Plenary Indulgences During All Souls Week (Nov. 2 - 8)

### On November 2nd (All Souls' Day) or the week of November 1-8

**Pious visit:** Visit a church or cemetery and pray for the deceased.

**Specific prayers:** At a church, say one "Our Father" and the "Apostles' Creed." At a cemetery, mental or vocal prayers for the dead are sufficient.

**To gain the indulgence, you must also meet these three prerequisites:**

**Confession:** Make a valid [sacramental confession](#) within about 20 days before or after the act.

**Communion:** Receive [Holy Communion](#) within about 20 days before or after the act.

**Prayer for the Pope:** Pray for the intentions of the Holy Father (at least one "Our Father" and one "Hail Mary" are suggested).

## Essential disposition

**Detachment from sin:** Be completely and wholeheartedly detached from all sin, including [venial sin](#); otherwise, only a partial indulgence is gained.

**One indulgence per day:** A person can only gain one plenary indulgence per day.

**Application to the souls in Purgatory:** These specific indulgences are applicable *only* to the souls in Purgatory and cannot be applied to oneself.

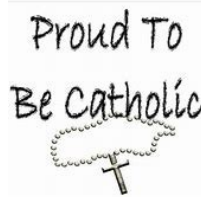
