As expenses rise due to inflation, these entities would still face higher costs but with restricted revenue growth. Over time, this could significantly impact the quality of services our residents rely on.

We support thoughtful tax policy. If changes are made to property taxes, they must include a clear, sustainable funding solution to ensure continued full and equitable funding for all essential services.
