Why did we change our name to Market Common Community Church?

We want to make it easy for the Market Common community (and the Myrtle Beach area in general!) to find us in our new spot. We believe our new name will simplify the search for a new church home for locals and tourists alike.

Why are we moving?

Six years ago we started Coastal Life Community Church out of General Robert H. Reed Rec Center with a vision of being a church plant in the Market Common area that could reach people for Jesus! The opportunity to purchase the location came and we made settlement in April of 2025.

What does this move mean for the current congregation?

Our congregation can expect to see a few changes in the coming days as it pertains to updating our new name and logo across platforms.
