Check-In & Pick-Up

Every child must be checked in before entering a classroom. You'll receive a matching security tag at check-in. Please keep your tag and present it when picking up your child.

Your Child's Safety Matters

- Secure check-in and pickup procedures
- Emergency response plans in place

Health & Wellness

If your child has a fever, vomiting, diarrhea, or another contagious illness, we ask that they remain home until symptom-free for at least 24 hours.

Need During Service?

If we need to reach you during worship, we will contact you using the information provided at check-in.

Emergency Procedures

If an evacuation is necessary, children will remain with their leaders and be escorted to the large lawn area outside. Parents should proceed directly to the designated family meeting area and wait for instructions. Children will be released using normal security procedures and only to those who have the matching security label.
