
Operation Christmas Child - A project of Samaritan's Purse which is an international relief organization. The Shoebox Gift Drive (held the third week of November) is an opportunity to bless children affected by war, poverty, natural disaster, famine, and disease around the world, as well as children living on Native American reservations in the United States. Before the millions of shoebox gifts collected can be distributed around the world, each one has to be carefully inspected and made ready for international shipment. Volunteers are needed to help with this process and must make arrangements to work at one of the Processing Center Locations. South Carolina Baptist Disaster Relief - A ministry offered by the South Carolina Baptist Convention that provides Christian love in action by bringing help, hope, and healing after a crisis. When storms come, disaster relief teams quickly follow - clearing debris, feeding the hungry, and helping families rebuild. Volunteers must complete a Disaster Relief Training Program and keep their certification current, so when a need arises and a disaster response is needed, volunteers are able to respond to the emergency. www.scbaptist.org

Coastline Women's Center - A private Christian organization in Conway dedicated to providing women and men with the services, support, and resources needed when facing untimely pregnancies. Abagail's Place is a ministry arm of Coastline Women's Center and provides additional free services such as parenting education, healing and recovery classes, and discipleship and Bible Studies. Volunteers are needed to serve as peer counselors and mentors, as well as clerical/administrative helpers and building/grounds workers. Socastee Pantry – A non-profit organization operated by Faith Outreach Ministries of the Grand Strand. Volunteers are primarily veterans, and the pantry provides food twice a week for people in the community who are in need. Food shipments are received on Mondays, and food distribution is completed on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Volunteers are needed to unload trucks, stock shelves, pack groceries, and pick up food donations at local Food Lion Stores, Crumbl Cookies, and Panera Bread.
