The Old Course Hotel, Golf Resort & Spa, regarded as one of Europe's leading resorts, has a slate roof covering at present, which is 28 years old and damaged by golf balls over the years. Euroshield's Heritage Slate was chosen because it is an environmentally friendly and accurate replication of the current slate roof. An added benefit for the Old Course Hotel, Golf Resort & Spa is Euroshield's ability to absorb and deflect the energy from golf ball impact without dents, cracks or damage. The current slate roof has considerable damage, cracked and broken tiles, from golf ball strikes over the years.

The installation will be undertaken by Braisby Roofing Ltd of Dunfermline, Fife.
