Program Eligibility & Fees - Homewood Residents Only

Camper Eligibility: Children in Kindergarten through 6th grade

NOTE: Camper must be age 5 on or before September 1, 2025

Homewood Residents Only

\$150 per camper

Christmas Camp is limited to the first 50 paid campers

Total Fee due with enrollment application — check or money order

* If your child is not admitted to camp, check or money order will be returned.

Registration Procedure

Homewood Residents: Registration forms can be dropped off at the Homewood Community Center beginning: **Wednesday, November 5th, 2025**

Registrations cannot be dropped off before: Wednesday, November 5th, 2025

Non-Homewood Residents: Not eligible for camp registration

- Registrations must contain fully completed forms and registration fee for each camper. Registration fee can be included via check or money order to **HOMEWOOD PARKS**. **Please do not fold registration forms; place in a large flat envelope**. If registering multiple children please include all in the same envelope. Should registration fee not be included, registration will be deemed incomplete and not accepted for consideration.
- Christmas Camp does not have unlimited availability. Registrations received on or before Friday, November 14th will receive notification by Wednesday, November 19th if they **have (or) have not** been admitted to camp.

Program Description

Campers will participate in traditional and non-traditional sports, fun games, field trips, arts & crafts projects, and more. Trained staff will supervise participants while emphasizing the importance of teamwork, good sportsmanship, and cooperation through games, sports, and group activities.

Camp Staff

The staff is mostly comprised of college students with experience in recreation, education backgrounds and youth leadership. All staff are certified in CPR, AED, basic first aid and child abuse prevention. The camp staff is dedicated to providing a fun and safe environment for each participant. The staff is responsible, qualified, and trained to work with children of all ages.

Camp Age Groups

Homewood Parks Christmas Camp staff will divide the registered campers into age appropriate groups.

What Your Camper will be doing at Camp

Normal Daily Activities: may include, dance, volleyball, basketball, kickball, movies, soccer, table games, playground, outside sports, relay races, four square, arts & crafts and much more.

Field Trips: campers will make age appropriate field trips during camp. Some examples of past field trips are: Laser Tag, Let's Play, Bowling, Pump it up, Chuck E Cheese, Movie Theatre, and more... Field trips have not been finalized at the time of publication.

Lunch & Snacks: Campers need to bring lunch, two snacks and drinks for each day during Christmas Camp.

Children with Special Needs

Homewood Parks and Recreation will accept children with special needs into our programs, and makes a reasonable effort to accommodate the child without fundamentally altering the day camp program. Homewood Parks is not able to provide personal assistants for children with special needs. If a child needs an aide please contact the Camp Director for directions in placing an assistant in our program to aide your child.
