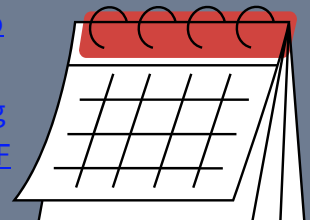

PAVILION RENTALS

Reservations are available at all pavilion locations 7 days a week pending availability. Pavilions rent in a time block of 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. with one rental per pavilion per day. The reservation fee varies depending on the size of the pavilion.

- One bounce house is allowed per pavilion rental.
- Water attractions are not allowed (i.e., water slides, slip in slides, water bounce houses or dunking booths)
- No colored paint or paintball guns, water balloons, silly string, or confetti.
- No vehicles are allowed on park grounds or at pavilion locations. This includes guests, vendors, food trucks and party entertainment.
- Alcohol is prohibited.

Reservations are booked In-person at the Business Office In the Homewood Community Center (1632 Oxmoor Road, Homewood, AL 35209), Monday-Friday, 8:00am – 5:30pm. Cash, credit /debit card and checks are accepted. To check availability please call 205-332-6700, during business office hours.

Pool Member Guest Policy

Members can bring 1 guest per day, per facility.

Guest fee is \$5.00 per facility entered.

All guests entering the pool facility are subject to the \$5.00 entry fee regardless of the guest's age.

Guest admittance to pools and community centers have separate registration and fees each day.

Registration of a guest must be made in person by the member with the guest present.

Homewood Parks & Recreation reserves the right to refuse guest privileges due to previous actions, occupancy levels, or program usage of the facility.

Senior Cost (Age 55+): \$70 1st household member that is 55+

Senior Renewing In-Person: \$10 2nd adult 55 & over

\$40 if 2nd adult is 54 & under

\$40 per additional household member age 22 & under

Senior Renewing Online (* if you meet the criteria): \$40 for additional member

Includes: Access to the Homewood Community Center, Lee Center, Senior Center (must be age 55+), Central Pool & Pool @ Patriot Park.

Total Access Monthly Membership

Available to Homewood residents only

Payments: Membership is paid month *12 month contract required

Monthly Cost: \$20 for 1st household member; \$4 per additional household member

***Members "per household" definition:** Homewood Parks & Recreation Board defines a household as two adults (23+ years of age) (2nd adult must be spouse and/or partner of 1st adult) and dependent children age 22 & under residing in the same household. Children three years & under are free of charge but will be issued a membership card for admittance to facilities.
