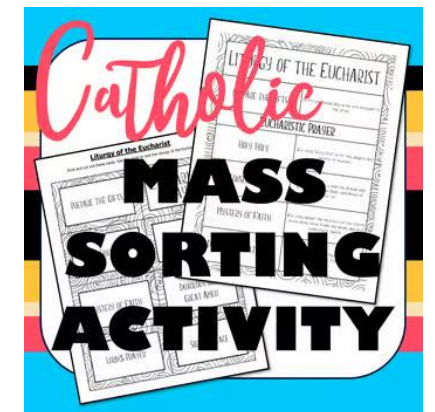
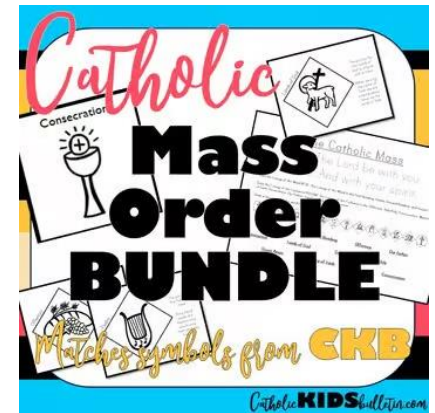

*This download is for use in 1 classroom. If you are using this for a parish or multiple classrooms, please buy multiple licenses based on the number of copies you are printing weekly. This is a rough guide, please adjust as needed based on your financial ability. I don't want the cost to prohibit these from being used, but I also need to pay for the time and effort that it takes to put together this resource. Thanks!*

- 1 Classroom: 1 license (click "Add one to cart")
  - Up to 100 copies each week: Buy 1 additional license
  - Up to 300 copies each week: Buy 2 additional licenses
  - Up to 500 copies each week: Buy 3 additional licenses

Ascension is listed without a date because most diocese move that feast to a Sunday; however, there are a few diocese in which it is a day of obligation. I left it without a date so you could use it on the Thursday or Sunday.

Some days, such as Ash Wednesday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday aren't Holy Days of Obligation, but they are included in the download.

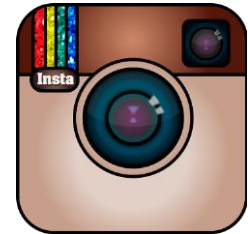

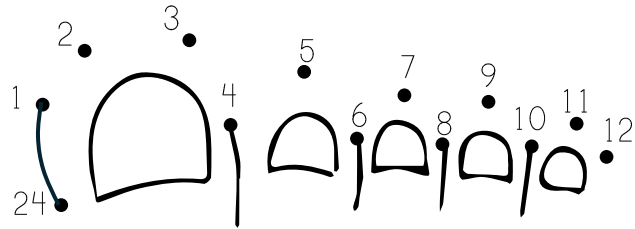


Did you get a palm branch at the beginning of Mass today? Hold your palm quietly during Mass, then take it home and keep it in a special place in your house.

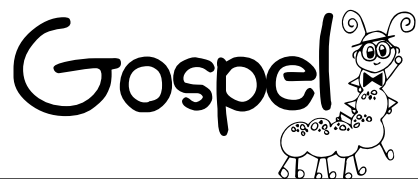
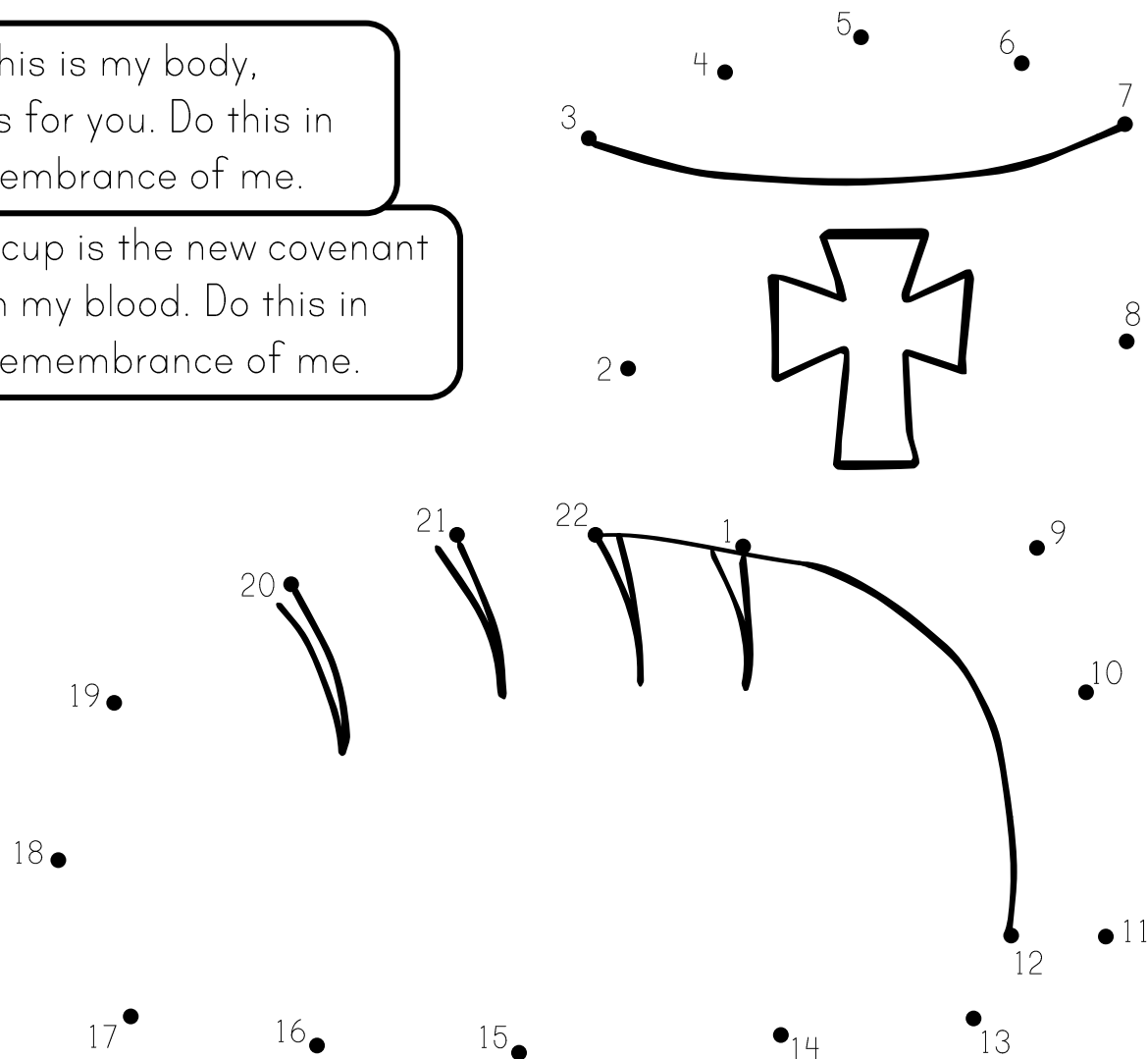


During the readings today, you will

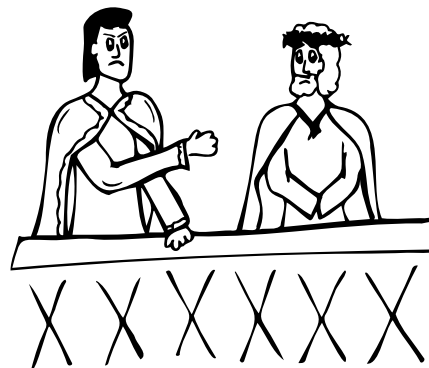


# Good Friday

Pontius Pilate asked the people to decide if Jesus should be killed. They yelled, "Crucify Him!"



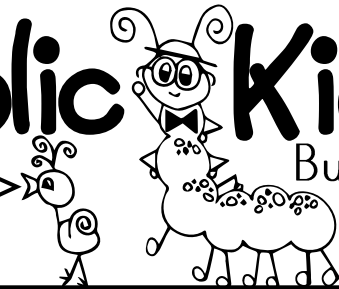
Jesus carried His cross. The writing on the cross read, "Jesus of Nazareth, the King of the Jews."

Each year, a new candle is lit during the Easter Vigil Mass. It is called the Paschal candle. This candle will be lit for every Mass during the Easter season. The Easter season lasts for 50 days.

## What is on a Paschal Candle?

Cross		Jesus died on the cross
Five grains of incense		A symbol of the 5 wounds of Jesus—in His hands, His feet, and His side
Five nails		Nails in Jesus' hands and feet and the spear in His side
Alpha & Omega		Greek letters for the beginning and the end. Another name for Jesus
Chi Rho		The first 2 letters of "Christ" in Greek
Lamb		Jesus is the Lamb of God
IHS		The first 3 letters of "Jesus" in Greek
Butterfly		A symbol of resurrection
Bread & Wine		A symbol of the Eucharist



The readings today tell the story of God's great works from Creation to Jesus' resurrection.
