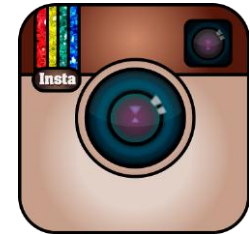
Some days, such as Ash Wednesday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday aren't Holy Days of Obligation, but they are included in the download.

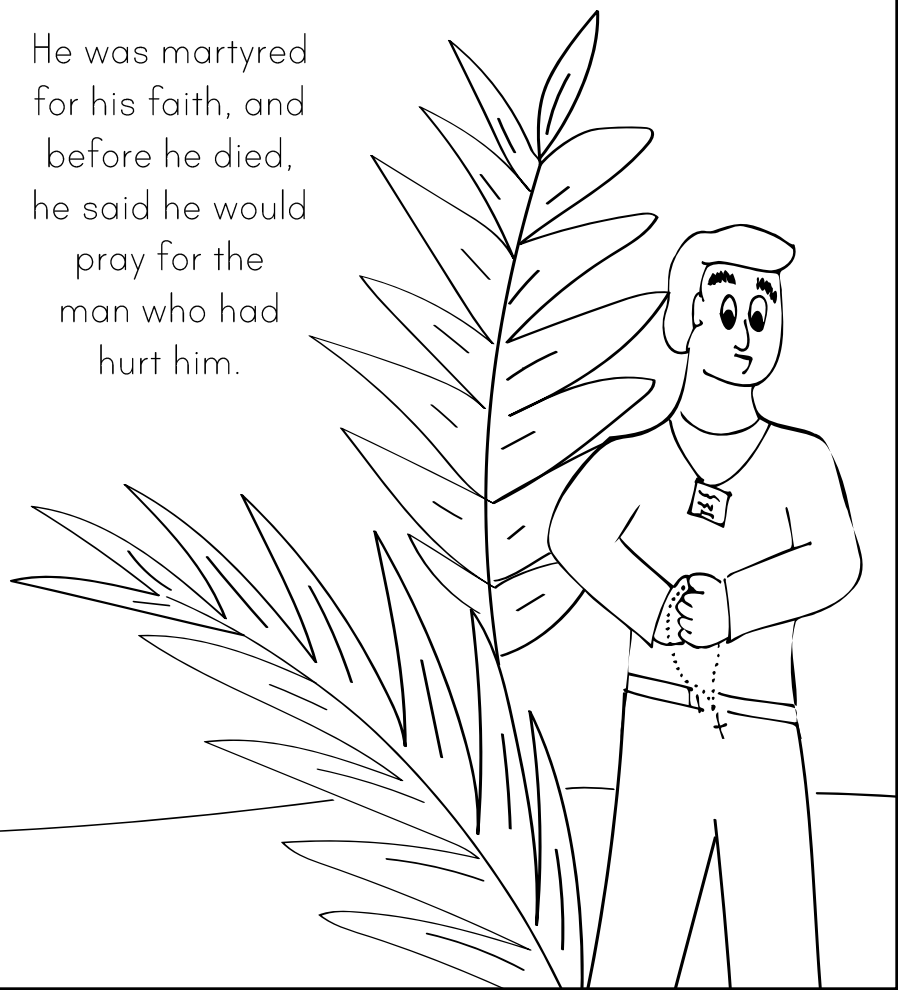


A little girl was sick, so her mom spoke to Jesus and asked him to heal her. The woman had faith and her daughter was healed!
