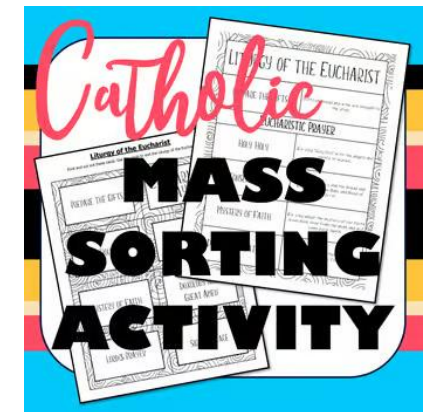
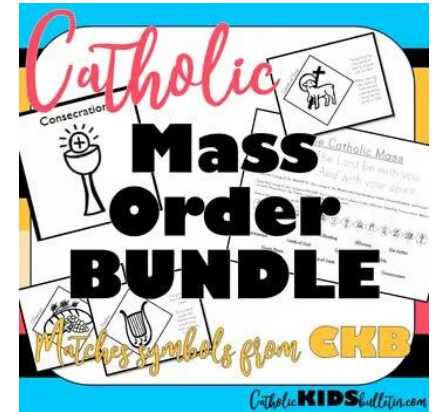

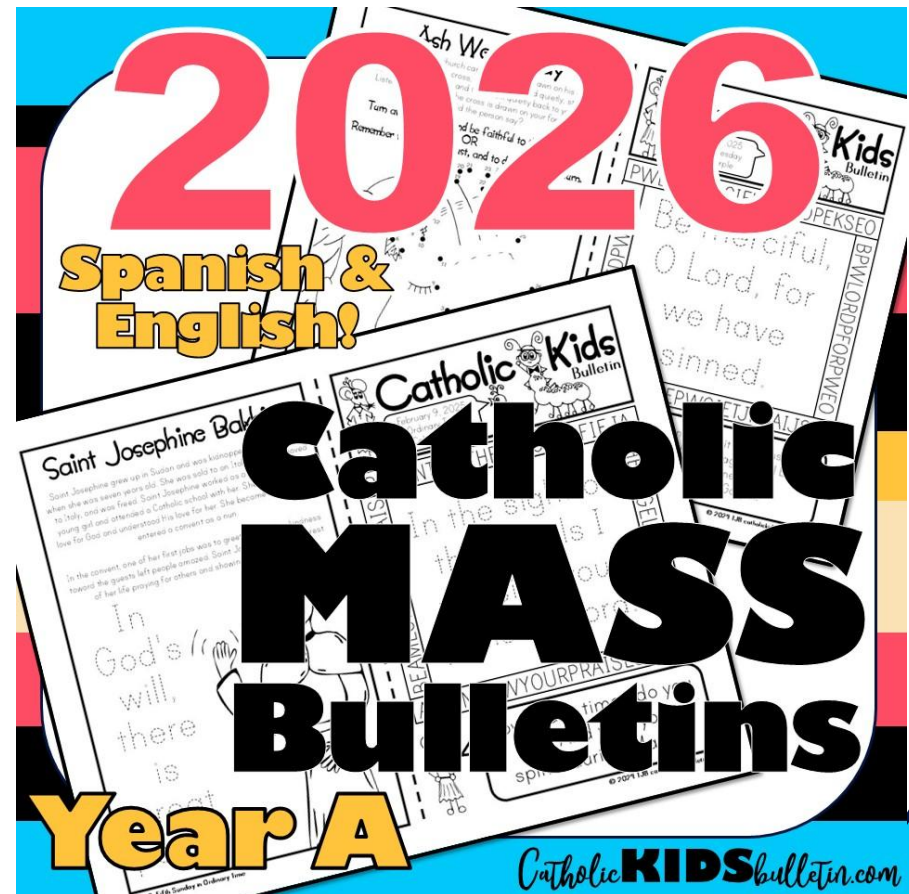

This download is for use in 1 classroom. If you are using this for a parish or multiple classrooms, please buy multiple licenses based on the number of copies you are printing weekly. This is a rough guide, please adjust as needed based on your financial ability. I don't want the cost to prohibit these from being used, but I also need to pay for the time and effort that it takes to put together this resource. Thanks!

- 1 Classroom: 1 license (click "Add one to cart")
 - Up to 100 copies each week: Buy 1 additional license

Ascension is listed without a date because most diocese move that feast to a Sunday; however, there are a few diocese in which it is a day of obligation. I left it without a date so you could use it on the Thursday or Sunday.

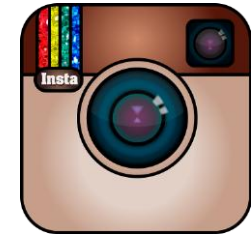
Some days, such as Ash Wednesday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday aren't Holy Days of Obligation, but they are included in the download.

During Lent, there are Sundays (3rd, 4th, and 5th) in which churches can use either the Year A readings or the Year A Scrutinies. Both are included and labeled on the lower left hand corner.

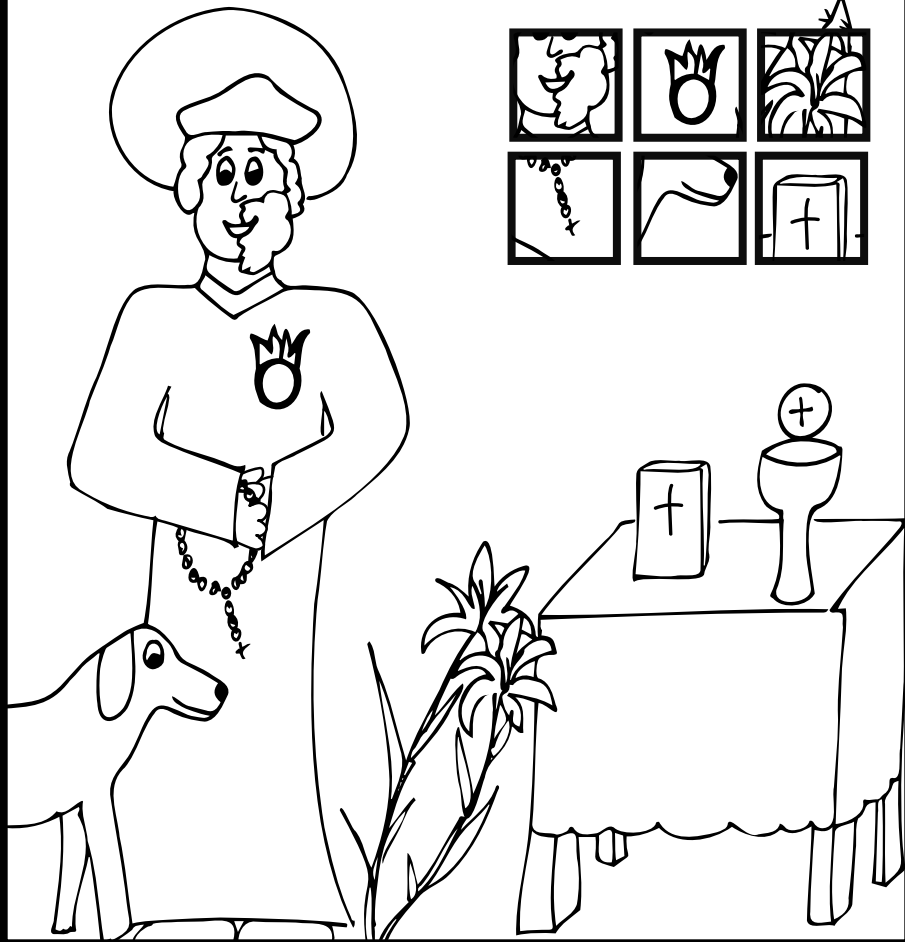
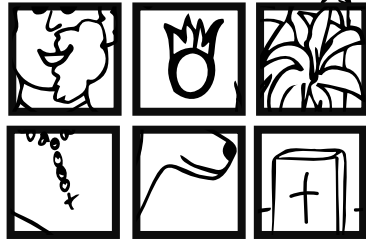
Gospel
