ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, share about a time when you saw them help someone.



Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone at the table answer this question: "When you see someone who needs help, what makes you want to help them, or what makes you not want to help them? How can Jesus give you the courage to help?"



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: "What are some things your friends or people you know are going through right now?" After they've shared, make sure you pray about them together at night.



Bed Time

Pray for each other: "God, when I see someone who needs help, may I be brave enough to set aside my fear of what someone might think and help them." Also, pray for the friends or people your kid mentioned in "Drive Time."
