Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone at the table answer this question: "When has someone stood up for you?"



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: "Have you ever had someone stand up for you, or you stood up for someone else?"



Bed Time

Pray for each other: "God, give us the courage to stand up for others when we have an opportunity. May we show them how You are fearless in the way You love us by the way we stand up for and love others."
